Resulting Farms With Double-Cropped Acres After FY 2003 Division

1 Overview

A Background

An internal flag is set in farm records during maintenance applications and farm reconstitutions when a farm's base acres exceed the effective DCP cropland plus double-cropped acres, if applicable.

The 2003 farm division software was released with an error in it so that the flag was being set incorrectly if the resulting farm's base acres exceeded the effective DCP cropland but were less than the effective DCP cropland plus double-cropped acres. An error message was displayed at the end of the reconstitution process for these farms.

As a result of the incorrect flag, CCC-509 **cannot** be processed for these farms.

B Software Correction

A correction to the software was transmitted to County Offices March 31, 2003. Follow Information Bulletin No. 2666 to load the software.

C Purpose

This notice provides instructions for resetting the internal flag.

A Resetting Flag

To reset the internal flag, access the farm maintenance application according to 3-CM (Rev. 3), paragraph 141.

Update the farm summary land data according to the following table.

Step	Screen	Action
1	MIBSYR01	ENTER "1", "2003 Fiscal Year".
2	MIB00001	ENTER "2", "Farm Summary Land Data".
3	MIB20001	ENTER "1", "Display and Update Farm Summary Land Data".
4	MIBSFO01	Enter 1 of the following and PRESS "Enter": <ul style="list-style-type: none">• farm number• tract number• producer's last or business name.
5	MIBUFL31	Do not make any changes to the data, PRESS "Cmd20" only .
