Potentially Erroneous Double-Cropped Acres Report

1 Overview

A Background

During a farm combination, double-cropped acres are accumulated from each parent farm to determine the resulting farms double-cropped acres. In some cases, the routine to accumulate the acres was not working correctly when the FY 2003 combination was processed. The software was corrected with County Release No. 512.

A report has been developed to help County Offices identify resulting farms that may have been affected by the software error.

B Purpose

This notice provides:

- a sample of a report that can be used to identify resulting farms that may not have the correct double-cropped acres
- instructions on how to correct farm maintenance.

The report will be printed automatically during installation of County Release No. 512.

B Report Format

The following is a sample of Report MIQ931-R001, "Potentially Erroneous Double-Cropped Acres Report". This report will provide:

- parent and resulting farm numbers
- double-cropped acres for a specific farm combination if the total of the parent farms double-cropped acres do not match the resulting farms double-cropped acres.

If a resulting farm listed is a parent farm of a subsequent reconstitution, the first reconstitution will be listed on the report with an asterisk (*). This indicates that there are subsequent reconstitutions and farms of all subsequent reconstitutions should be reviewed for accuracy.

3 County Office Action

A Review Data on Report MIQ931-R001

County Offices shall review the resulting farms on Report MIQ931-R001 for accuracy of the resulting farm double-cropped acres. Use FSA-156EZ's that printed when the reconstitution was initiated to determine the correct number of double-cropped acres for the resulting farm.

In determining if the double-cropped acres in the system are incorrect, take into account if the acres were intentionally reduced through maintenance.

B Revising Farm Summary Land Data

If the resulting farms double-cropped acres are incorrect, update the double-cropped acres according to 3-CM (Rev. 3), paragraphs 201 and 202.
