1 AD-1026A Information

A Background

AD-1026A was initially developed as a tool for producers to verify highly erodible land and wetland conservation determinations on farms in which they had a farming interest. Since its inception, AD-1026A has been used for **many** purposes.

Note: AD-1026A is **no longer** required.

The burden on existing web servers is extreme. AD-1026A's strain web servers even more because of the volume of information that must be returned to complete AD-1026A printing. Reporting databases were developed to eliminate stress on web servers. By eliminating this stress, users of applications that require access to live databases would **not** be inhibited because of the printing of reports that could use information from a reporting database. Reporting databases update once a day.

B Purpose

This notice informs State and County Offices that:

- AD-1026A uses a reporting database
- **Note:** Any information printed on AD-1026A will be updated from the previous workday's activities.
- Web Transmittal No. 139 informed users that AD-1026A's use a reporting database
- 3-CM, subparagraph 246 A states that the AD-1026A printout uses the reporting database. The reporting database is only updated once a day. Any changes made during the current workday will **not** be reflected on the AD-1026A printout until the following workday.
