

2014 Farm Bill Software Updates

1 Overview

A Background

MIDAS Release 2.1 and a concurrent release in FRS (web-based Farm Records) include updates incorporating new and revised data fields necessary to implement the ARCPLC program, and other provisions contained in the 2014 Farm Bill. Changes in certain functionality of MIDAS Farm Records and FRS are associated with the new data fields.

FSA-156EZ and FSA-476DCP have been changed and will provide information for the new data fields.

B Purpose

This notice provides an:

- explanation of the new and revised data fields in MIDAS Farm Records and FRS and explains the use of the data fields
- overview of the revisions to FSA-156EZ and FSA-476DCP.

Note: A new handbook for MIDAS Farm Records and FRS is currently being drafted. These changes will be incorporated into the new handbook when it is released.

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2 Changes to Farm Records

A New Data Fields

The following new data fields have been added to MIDAS Farm Records and to 2014 and 2015 FRS:

- **ARCPLC election:**

- a farm level data element that reflects the choice of either Agricultural Risk Coverage (ARC) Individual for the farm or ARC County, or Price Loss Coverage (PLC) for crops on the farm that are required to have an election
- will be blank until the import of ARCPLC election data occurs
- if an edit is made on the farm before the import of ARCPLC election data, the system will require an ARCPLC election before edits can be saved
- a temporary place-holder election of ARC individual:
 - automatically added by the system within MIDAS Farm Records
 - must be added by the user when edits are made to a record in 2014 FRS

Note: The place-holder election of ARC individual will be over-written with the official election made by the producers associated with the farm when the ARCPLC election import occurs. Entry of any election choice other than ARC individual before the ARCPLC election import is **not** authorized.

- **Historical Irrigation Percentage (HIP):**

- a farm level data element that reflects HIP used in calculations of ARC County payments
- only applicable to specific crops in designated counties, and only applicable when the election choice for the crop is ARC County
- entry of HIP is **not** authorized at this time
- after the ARCPLC import occurs, when HIP is applicable, entry of HIP is required **before** edits can be saved
- modification of the “HIP” data field is permitted until **September 1, 2015**
- after **September 1, 2015**, and once HIP is entered for a crop, it **cannot** be changed except by authorized State Office users

2 Changes to Farm Records (Continued)

A New Data Fields (Continued)

- **Farm Level PLC Yield:**
 - a farm level data element used to maintain established yields for ARCPLC covered crops with no base acres, that are required to have an ARCPLC election because the farm contains generic base acres
 - when an ARCPLC covered crop with no base acres has an election of PLC on these farms and there are acres of the crop planted, an established yield **must** be loaded at the farm level for the crop for use in the calculation of PLC payments
 - entry of farm level PLC yields is **not** authorized at this time
 - procedure for establishing farm level PLC yields will be incorporated into a future amendment of 1-ARCPLC
 - **Native Sod (only applicable to the States of IA, MN, MT, NE, ND, and SD and adjacent counties):**
 - a data element that applies only to land physically located in the States of IA, MN, MT, NE, ND, and SD
 - used to track the number of acres of native sod broken out after **February 7, 2014**.
- Note:** Native sod broken out after **February 7, 2014**, is **not** eligible for FCIC premium subsidy and is subject to increased NAP fees until the 4-year cropping requirements are met.

B Revised Data Fields

The following are revised data fields:

- **CTAP Transitional Yield:**
 - replaced the data field formerly known as direct yield
 - only applicable to generic (formerly cotton) base acres
 - must be greater than zero when generic base acres are greater than zero

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2 Changes to Farm Records (Continued)

B Revised Data Fields (Continued)

- **PLC Yield:**
 - replaced the data field formerly known as CC yield
 - applies to all crops except generic base acres
 - must be greater than zero for any crop other than generic when base acres for that crop are greater than zero
- **Base Acres:**
 - will now be maintained in 100ths instead of 10ths
 - the “Base Acre” data field within 2014 and 2015 FRS has been modified to accept base acre entries stated in hundredths
 - the restriction from entering base acres in hundredths has been removed from MIDAS Farm Records
- **Crop Year:**
 - used for new base acre entries, such as return of base acres previously reduced to zero on CCC-505 for CRP Enrollment
 - within MIDAS Farm Records has been changed to a display-only field that is defaulted to the current FY
- **CCC-505 CRP Reduction Acres:**
 - will now be maintained in 100ths instead of 10ths
 - the “CCC-505 CRP Reduction Acre” data field within 2014 and 2015 FRS has been modified to accept base acre entries stated in hundredths
 - the restriction from entering CCC-505 CRP reduction acres in hundredths has been removed from MIDAS Farm Records.

C Removed Data Field

The “PTPP Reduction Acres” data field has been removed because the Planting Transferability Pilot Project (PTPP) Program is no longer authorized.

3 ARCPLC Related Changes

A ARCPLC Election, HIP, and Farm Level PLC Yield Within MIDAS Farm Records

Within MIDAS Farm Records, the ARCPLC election, HIP, and farm level PLC yield will be displayed and edited at the farm level in a new “Crop Election Data” assignment block that will be located between the “Land Data” and “Crop Data” assignment blocks.

Following is an example of the “Crop Election Data” assignment block.

Until import of the ARCPLC election data occurs, the election choice will be blank. When a farm is placed into edit mode, a temporary place-holder election of ARC individual will be automatically populated by the system. Users **shall not** change this temporary place-holder election.

- **ARCPLC election choice.**
 - After import of the ARCPLC election data occurs, edits to existing ARCPLC elections are permitted (subject to ARCPLC rules) to handle corrections and appeals through **September 1, 2015**. Edits made to 2015 elections must be coordinated with 2014 elections. Election choice for a farm must remain the same for both 2014 and 2015.
 - **After September 1, 2015**, any edits to existing ARCPLC election choices must be submitted to the National Office. New elections for added crops, such as return of base acres for a crop that previously had its base acres reduced to zero for CRP enrollment, will still be permitted.

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3 ARCPLC Related Changes (Continued)

A ARCPLC Election, HIP, and Farm Level PLC Yield Within MIDAS Farm Records (Continued)

- **“HIP” data field.**
 - This data field will only be enabled for designated counties where HIP applies and only for specific designated crops within those counties when the designated crop has an ARCPLC election choice of ARC County.
 - After September 1, 2015, any edits to existing HIP values must be submitted to the State Office. New HIP values for added crops, such as return of base acres for a crop that previously had its base acres reduced to zero for CRP enrollment, will still be permitted.
- **PLC Yield.**
 - Will be enabled for edits at the farm level in MIDAS if the crop has zero base acres and the ARCPLC election choice for the crop is PLC.
 - Crops with base acres greater than zero will display “0.0000” for the farm level PLC yield in the “Crop Election Data” assignment block and will not be editable within that assignment block. PLC yields for crops with base acres are edited at the tract level.

B New Yield Labels Within MIDAS Farm Records

The following are new yield labels within MIDAS farm records.

- **“Tract Crop Data” Assignment Block.**
 - Following is an example of the “Tract Crop Data” assignment block.

- CTAP transitional yield will be displayed as zero for all crops except generic and must be greater than zero for generic when generic base acres are greater than zero.
- PLC yield will be displayed as zero for generic and must be greater than zero for all other crops when base acres for those crops are greater than zero.

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3 ARCPLC Related Changes (Continued)

B New Yield Labels Within MIDAS Farm Records (Continued)

- **“Tract CCC-505 CRP Reduction Data” Assignment Block.**
- Following is an example of the “Tract CCC-505 CRP Reduction Data” assignment block.

- CTAP Transitional (Direct) yield and PLC (CC) yield columns are enabled or disabled for editing based upon the contract start year:
 - only the CTAP Transitional (Direct) yield column is editable for CRP Contracts with a start year before 2002 since only Direct yields existed at that time
 - both the CTAP Transitional (Direct) yield and PLC (CC) yield are editable for CRP Contracts with start years between 2002 and 2013.
- Either the CTAP Transitional (Direct) yield or the PLC (CC) yield will be enabled for CRP Contracts with start years after 2013 depending upon the crop:
 - only the CTAP Transitional (Direct) yield is enabled for editing when the selected crop is generic (formerly cotton)
 - only the PLC (CC) yield is enabled for editing when the selected crop is any crop other than generic.

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3 ARCPLC Related Changes (Continued)

C ARCPLC Election, HIP, and Farm Level PLC Yield Within FRS

Within FRS, the ARCPLC election, HIP, and farm level PLC yield will be summarized on the Crop Selection Screen. Following is an example of the Crop Selection Screen.

3 ARCPLC Related Changes (Continued)

C ARCPLC Election, HIP, and Farm Level PLC Yield Within FRS (Continued)

- **ARCPLC Election Choice.**
 - Edits to ARCPLC election are made by crop within the Select Crop Screen.
 - ARCPLC election is not displayed for generic crops because ARCPLC election is not applicable to generic crops.
 - After import of the ARCPLC election data occurs, edits to existing ARCPLC elections are permitted (subject to ARCPLC rules) to handle corrections and appeals through September 1, 2015. Edits made to 2014 elections must be coordinated with 2015 elections. Election choice for a farm must remain the same for both 2014 and 2015.
 - After September 1, 2015, any edits to existing 2014 ARCPLC election choices must be submitted to the National Office.
 - New elections for added crops, that is appeals or corrections, are permitted and are entered at the Crop Base Data Screen after selecting the crop from the Select Crop Screen.
 - Until import of the ARCPLC election data occurs, the ARCPLC election choice within 2014 FRS will be blank. When a farm is edited in 2014 FRS before import of ARCPLC election data, a temporary place-holder election of ARC individual must be entered by the user before edits can be saved. Users **must** choose ARC individual as the election and **are not** authorized to choose any other election choice before import of ARCPLC election data.
- **HIP.**
 - On the Select Crop Screen, HIP will only be displayed for specific HIP-eligible crops with an ARCPLC election choice of ARC County in counties where HIP applies.
 - Entry of HIP and edits to HIP are made on the Select Crop Screen.
 - After September 1, 2015, any edits to existing HIP values must be submitted to the State Office.
 - New HIP values for added crops, such as appeals or corrections, are permitted and are entered at the Crop Base Data Screen after selecting the crop from the Select Crop Screen.

3 ARCPLC Related Changes (Continued)

C ARCPLC Election, HIP, and Farm Level PLC Yield Within FRS (Continued)

- **PLC Yield.**
 - Farm level PLC yield will be displayed on the Select Crop Screen for crops with base acres.
 - For crops with zero base acres on a farm containing generic base acres, a farm level PLC yield is needed for ARCPLC payment calculation if the crop with zero base acres has been planted and the crop has an ARCPLC election choice of PLC.
 - Farm level PLC yields for crops with zero base acres are entered on the crop’s base data screen after selecting the crop from the Select Crop Screen.
 - Farm level PLC yields for crops with zero base acres are entered only once, regardless of the number of tracts, and are entered in the “Farm Level PLC” data field near the top of the screen as follows.

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3 ARCPLC Related Changes (Continued)

D New Yield Labels Within FRS

CTAP transitional yield will be displayed only for generic crops and is only displayed when generic base acres are greater than zero.

PLC yield will be displayed only for non-generic crops and will only be displayed if base acres for the crop are:

- greater than zero
- zero, and generic acres are present on the farm, the ARCPLC election for the crop is PLC, and a farm level PLC yield has been established for the crop according to subparagraph C.

4 Native Sod


A Native Sod Within MIDAS Farm Records

A new “Native Sod” assignment block will be displayed for all farm records in all States, but is editable only for fields physically located within the States of IA, MN, MT, NE, ND, and SD.

Native sod acres must be delineated as a separate field within GIS. Delineation as a separate field:

- limits assignment of native sod attributes to the specific area broken out
- prevents the area subject to native sod restrictions from being combined with other fields until the 4-year planting requirement is met.

Following is an example of the “Native Sod” assignment cropping block in MIDAS Farm Records.

Within the “Native Sod” assignment block for each field broken out after February 7, 2014, users must enter the following.

- The date the native sod was broken out. This date **cannot** be before February 7, 2014, or later than the current date.
- A 4-digit planting year for each year that the area is cropped (including perennials) on the “Native Sod” field. Entry of planting years is restricted to the years 2014 through the current year.

Note: The total acreage of fields with native sod attributes for each tract is replicated to current year FRS from MIDAS farm records.

B Native Sod Within FRS

For years after 2013, but before the current year, Native Sod acres are maintained and edited on the Tract Data Screen within FRS and aggregate to the Farm Data Screen. To account for the possibility that land physically located in 1 of the 6 designated States may be administered by another State, entry of native sod attributes is permitted for tracts on farms administered by counties adjacent to the States of IA, MN, MT, NE, ND, and SD, when the physical location of the tract is within 1 of the 6 designated States. The date the native sod acres are broken out and the years planted are not maintained in FRS.

5 Revised Forms

A FSA-156EZ

FSA-156EZ has been modified as follows.

- A Crop Election Section has been added and ARCPLC election choices by crop will be displayed in this section.
- The Crop Election Section is divided into ARC individual, ARC County, and PLC subsections.
- Crops are listed in the boxes for each subsection according to the election choice applicable to the crop.
- Yield labels have been changed to reflect new CTAP and PLC yield names.

Note: See Exhibit 1 for an example of the revised FSA-156EZ.

B FSA-476

FSA-476 has been modified to update yield labels from direct and CC yields to CTAP transitional yield and PLC yield.

Note: See Exhibit 2 for an example of the revised FSA-476DCP.

B County Office Action

County Offices shall follow the contents of this notice when viewing and editing ARCPLC elections, HIP, yields, and native sod acres.
