Background

The CMA Process provides approved CMA's and LSA's with:

- producer eligibility
- farm eligibility
- producer PLM's.

The CMA Process uses FSA-578 data uploaded to KCMO from Administrative County Offices:

- ME.P9M, Compliance Producer Share File
- ME.S9M, Compliance Summary File.

The CMA Process uses the FSA-578 files to report data through CMA Process Output File Fields:

- [26], Farm Serial Number
- [29], Reported Acres
- [30], Determined Acres
- [33], Crop Share
- [49], Crop/Producer not found on Compliance File
- [55], No Reported or Determined Acres.

Purpose

This notice informs CMA's and LSA's:

- that all applicable FSA-578 data is being uploaded to KCMO
 - that the CMA Process is now reporting crop and acreage data accurately
 - to no longer ignore CMA Process Fields [49] and [55].

2 CMA Process Crop and Acreage Data

CMA/LSA Action

CMA's and LSA's shall no longer ignore ineligible CMA Process records flagged with fields [49] and [55].

Enhancements to the upload of FSA-578 data to KCMO were:

- made to correct inaccurate reporting in CMA Process Fields [49] and [55]
- included in County Software Release No. 415 that was received by County Offices beginning August 30, 1999.

Enhanced upload of FSA-578 data is being received by KCMO. PSD has researched flagging of CMA Process records and determined that Fields [49] and [55] are reporting accurately.

CMA's and LSA's encountering problems with CMA Process reporting in Fields [49], [55], or other fields shall immediately report occurrences to PSD-URB.
