1 Overview

A Background

Pub. L. 109-234, Section 3015, the Emergency Agricultural Disaster Assistance Act of 2006, enacted on June 15, 2006, provided assistance to producers and first-handlers of 2005 crop of cottonseed in hurricane-affected counties. A final rule published in FR on October 31, 2006, added 7 CFR Part 1427, subpart H and implements the 2005 Cottonseed Payment Program.

The signup period began October 31, 2006, and ends on December 29, 2006, unless otherwise announced. Subject to funds availability and payment caps, \$15 million is available for the 2005 Cottonseed Payment Program.

B Purpose

This notice provides:

- cotton gins with instructions for preparing and submitting applications for payment
- applicable State and County Offices with program policies and their responsibilities.

2 2005 Cottonseed Payment Program Responsibilities

A Cotton Gin Responsibilities

According to this notice and 7 CFR Part 1427, Subpart H, cotton gins shall:

- determine, subject to PSD verification, whether the cotton gin and producers are eligible for the 2005 Cottonseed Payment Program by reviewing the FSA-provided list of hurricane affected counties
- gather data and perform calculations necessary to prepare an application for payment
- prepare and submit CCC-Cotton A-6 (9-18-06) for payment (see subparagraph 5 A)
- receive and distribute payments to producers
- maintain application and payment records according to subparagraph 6 C.

B County Office Responsibilities

With direction from State Offices, County Offices shall:

- assist with publicizing the 2005 Cottonseed Payment Program to cotton gins that may be eligible by:
 - issuing press releases and newsletters publicizing the contents of this notice during the signup period
 - forwarding this notice to cotton gins that may be eligible
- provide producer data to cotton gins that is not available from PSD.

Note: Cotton gins may need acreage data for crop year 2005 to calculate an assumed 2003 lint delivery amount. 2-INFO, subparagraph 69 B allows the limited release of cotton acreage to cotton ginners.

2 2005 Cottonseed Payment Program Responsibilities (Continued)

C PSD Responsibilities

PSD shall:

- administer the 2005 Cottonseed Payment Program requirements in this notice
- provide eligible county and NASS yield data to assist cotton gins
- accept and process CCC-Cotton A-6's for payments from cotton gins
- prepare a payment file for submission to KCFO for subsequent payments
- provide oversight for any necessary 2005 Cottonseed Payment Program reviews.

3 Cotton Gin Eligibility, Lint Quantity, Payment Quantity, Payment Rate, and Payments

A Cottonseed and Applicant Eligibility

To be eligible for payment:

- cotton must have been produced during 2005 in a hurricane-affected county, that is, a county declared a natural disaster or included in the geographic area covered by a natural disaster declaration related to Hurricane Katrina, Hurricane Ophelia, Hurricane Rita, Hurricane Wilma, a related condition, or a county contiguous to such a county

Note: Counties declared for Hurricane Dennis only are **not** included. A spreadsheet in Microsoft Excel format listing eligible counties is available at <http://www.fsa.usda.gov/FSA/webapp?area=home&subject=prsu&topic=ldp-as> and also in Exhibit 1.

- cottonseed must be the result of ginning 2005 crop cotton by the applicant
- cottonseed at the gin must **not** have been destroyed or damaged by fire, flood, or other events such that its loss or damage was compensated by other local, State, Federal Government, private or public insurance, or disaster relief payments
- applicants **must** be an eligible first handler of cotton that has an eligible payment quantity; this is gins that ginned 2005 crop cotton for the producer

Exception: If the 2005 gin is no longer in business to the extent the company has no means to apply for payment on behalf of producers and distribute funds, the current gin becomes the applicant.

- applicants **must** submit a complete CCC-Cotton A-6 (9-18-06) and a supporting worksheet by no later than 12 a.m. (midnight) December 29, 2006, unless an extension of time is announced by CCC.

Note: Applications received after application deadline will **not** be accepted for payment.

3 Cotton Gin Eligibility, Lint Quantity, Payment Quantity, Payment Rate, and Payments (Continued)

B Total Lint Payment Quantity

The applicant's payment quantity of cottonseed will be:

- calculated by the applicant
- submitted on CCC-Cotton A-6 (9-18-06) for approval by CCC
- based on the determination of the total amount of **2003 crop lint deliveries** by cotton producers in eligible counties subject to the following provisions:
 - the 2003 crop lint delivery determination will be made by the applicant:
 - for each eligible county, producer by producer
 - based upon producer certification, ginning records, or other relevant information as applicable
 - if the producer delivered 2003 crop cotton to gins different from the gin that received 2005 crop deliveries, the 2005 gin shall do 1 of the following:
 - contact the other gins for production information
 - obtain other proof of the eligible quantity from the cotton producer
 - if the producer delivered cotton to more than one 2005 gin, each gin shall be an applicant
 - if the producer did **not** deliver cotton to the same gins in 2003 as 2005, the applicants shall divide the total 2003 production equally between each applicant gin
 - if the producer did not grow any 2005 crop cotton in the eligible county, the applicant shall **not** apply for payment on behalf of the producer

3 Cotton Gin Eligibility, Lint Quantity, Payment Quantity, Payment Rate, and Payments (Continued)

B Total Lint Payment Quantity (Continued)

- if the producer grew 2005 crop cotton but did **not** produce 2003 crop cotton on any farm, the producer shall be considered a new producer; in this case, the applicant shall:
 - compute an assumed 2003 lint delivery amount by multiplying the 2003 USDA NASS county average yield for the applicable county times the producer's 2005 cotton acreage in the eligible county
 - obtain proof of 2005 cotton acreage from 1 of the following:
 - producer certification
 - FSA County Office FSA-578's
 - crop insurance records

Note: NASS county average yield data is available at <http://www.fsa.usda.gov/FSA/webapp?area=home&subject=prsu&topic=ldp-as>. If the NASS county average yield is **not** computed for the applicable county, the applicant shall use the NASS county average yield for the nearest cotton producing county with the highest NASS county average yield.

- calculated individually with respect to all eligible cotton producers and those individual eligibilities for the gin will then be added together to determine the total lint eligibility of the gin.

C Total Payment Quantity

From the amount of total lint eligibility, the cotton gin's payment quantity will be calculated by PSD by converting the total lint quantity to a cottonseed equivalent by using a factor representing the Olympic average of estimated pounds of cottonseed per pound of cotton ginned cotton lint, as determined by CCC for the 5 years preceding the 2005 crop year. The factor is 1.54176.

3 Cotton Gin Eligibility, Lint Quantity, Payment Quantity, Payment Rate, and Payments (Continued)

D Payment Rate and Payments

CCC shall:

- determine the payment rate (dollars per ton) by dividing the total available 2005 Cottonseed Payment Program funds by the total eligible payment quantity of cottonseed
- if determined necessary, establish a reserve of funds to be used for corrections
- limit the total payment to an eligible applicant not to exceed \$98 per ton of cottonseed multiplied by the applicant's total eligible payment quantity
- distribute payments to cotton gins as soon as possible after making necessary payment calculations
- make deductions to payments to honor valid claims by other USDA agencies such as AMS.

Applicants receiving payments shall:

- after receiving payments, verify that amounts received were correct
- submit requests for additional payments or refunds to PSD
- pay demands for refunds as instructed by PSD.

E Sharing Payments With Producers

Applicants agree to share any payment with the producer of the cotton that was the basis of the payment to the extent that the effect of the loss of cottonseed was borne by the producer rather than the cotton gin. To the extent that such funds will go to individual producers, those funds will be considered to have been received by the applicant on behalf of such producers.

4 Lint Loss Worksheet Instructions and Example

The worksheet is in Microsoft Excel format and will be available at <http://www.fsa.usda.gov/FSA/webapp?area=home&subject=prsu&topic=ldp-as>. Cotton gins shall prepare a worksheet to support CCC-Cotton A-6 according to the following instructions.

Column	Instructions
Title Bar	Enter the cotton gin code.
A	Enter the State and county code where the producer's cotton was grown. This data is available from the eligible county list. Note: Lint amounts are entered on CCC-Cotton A-6 by cotton gin, State, and county. It is suggested that spreadsheet entries be sorted by State and county code and subtotals be calculated.
B	Enter the applicable FSA FSN. Note: At the option of the cotton gin, amounts for more than 1 FSN may be added together and entered on the worksheet as an aggregate amount for the producer.
C	Enter the producer's name or ID number associated with the FSN.
D	If known, enter the weight in pounds of lint produced from the 2003 crop by the producer.
E	For new producers only , determined according to subparagraph 3 B, enter the applicable NASS county average yield.
F	For new producers only , enter the 2005 planted acreage obtained according to subparagraph 3 B.
G	Make no entry. The result of the formula in each cell is the eligible lint loss for payment before conversion to cottonseed equivalent. For each county, transfer the subtotals and grand total to CCC-Cotton A-6.

5 CCC-Cotton A-6 Submission, Instructions, and Example (Continued)

B Preparation Instructions

Cotton gins shall complete CCC-Cotton A-6 according to the following instructions.

Item	Instruction
2	Enter name and mailing address of the cotton gin. This address should be the record keeping office for the company.
3A	Enter name of the financial institution for automated clearinghouse direct deposit (not wire transfer).
3B	Enter complete account number for the institution identified in item 3A.
3C	Enter 9-digit routing number of the financial institution identified in item 3A.
3D	Check the appropriate box to indicate if the account identified in item 3B is a checking or a savings account.
4A	Enter name of the person at the cotton gin identified in item 2 to be contacted about this application.
4B	Enter telephone number, including area code, for the contact person identified in item 4A.
4C	Enter e-mail address for the contact person identified in item 4A.
5	Enter taxpayer ID number in items A, B, or C. Note: Enter ID number in 1 field only depending on the type of ID number.
6	Enter names and addresses of any cotton gins, other than the cotton gin identified in item 2 that will be included in this application.
7	Enter 5-digit cotton gin code for each cotton gin included in this application. Note: The cotton gin code should be correct for the cotton gin identified in Part A, item 2. Companies having 1 taxpayer ID number and operating multiple cotton gins should combine the applications of all their cotton gins onto 1 application.
8	Enter State and county names and numeric codes where the cotton was grown. Note: This may require the use of more than 1 line in Part B. Use additional forms for continuation if necessary and enter a grand total of the lint weight on the last page.
9	Enter total of lost lint weight in whole pounds calculated for each producer by State and county according to paragraphs 3 and 4. E-mail the applicable worksheet prepared according to paragraph 4 to chris.kyer@wdc.usda.gov .
10	Enter total of column 9 for each line in Part B.
11A	Enter signature of an authorized individual of the cotton gin identified in item 2.
11B	Enter title of the individual signing in item 13A.
11C	Enter date the individual identified in item 13A signed CCC-Cotton A 6.
12	Enter any remarks that are pertinent or supporting to the information entered on this application.

6 Applicant Liabilities

A Fraudulent Representations

If any person makes any erroneous or fraudulent representation in obtaining a cottonseed payment in this part, or in connection with such a payment engages in a scheme or device that tends to defeat the purposes of this program, the person shall be liable to CCC for the amount of the payment plus interest on such payment as determined by CCC. Such remedy will be in addition to whatever additional remedies may be allowed by law.

B Duplicate or Excess Benefits

If more than 1 person executes a program payment application with CCC on the same quantity and payments are made there under, each such person shall be jointly and severally liable for any violation of the terms and conditions for any payment made to anyone under that application or for any refund due from any person signing that application. Such liability shall remain until payment in full is made of any such refund and its related charges.

If a person receives a program payment in excess of the amount authorized, that person shall refund to CCC an amount equal to the excess payment, plus interest thereon, as determined by CCC.

C Records Retention

For 3 years after the date of the application for 2005 crop payments, the applicant shall keep records, including records supporting the quantity of cottonseed for which payment was requested, and furnish such information and reports relating to the application to CCC as requested. Such records shall be available at all reasonable times for an audit or inspection by authorized representatives of CCC, USDA, or the Comptroller General of the United States. Failure to keep or make records available may result in refund to CCC of all payment received, plus interest thereon, as determined by CCC. In the event of a controversy about payments, records **must** be kept for such longer period as may be specified by CCC until such controversy is resolved. Destruction of records at any time is at the risk of the applicant.
