1 FY 2005 Compliance

A Background

County Offices that had Common Land Units (CLU's) in prior years had their compliance imagery flown under a national contract known as the National Agriculture Imagery Program (NAIP). APFO contracted for NAIP imagery for over 2000 counties in FY 2004. The plan for FY 2005 was to contract through APFO for compliance imagery for all counties with CLU's. Budget constraints have limited the number of States for which compliance imagery for FY 2005 NAIP can be obtained. States selected to be flown were based on data from programs that rely on specific acreages for payment calculations. All States that have partners for cost sharing for imagery in FY 2005 were also selected. States that are not flown using NAIP and have not already contracted to fly on their own will **not** receive compliance imagery. No additional funding will be authorized to contract with local vendors.

B Purpose

- a list of those States that are scheduled to receive NAIP imagery for FY 2005 (see Exhibit 1)
- procedure for State and County Offices for FY 2005 compliance activities.

2 Procedure

A County Offices with FY 2005 Imagery

County Offices with CLU's that **receive** imagery for FY 2005 shall follow procedure in 2-CP for selecting and determining farms and crops for spot check.

The Compliance Tool used to determine acreage using digital imagery and CLU's will be available to County Offices by July 1, 2005. State Offices that have not had Compliance Tool training will receive training from General Dynamics before delivery of the imagery. A training video is also available with the Compliance Tool install.

B County Offices Without FY 2005 NAIP Imagery

County Offices that do **not** receive Compliance Imagery shall spot check only "required farms and crops" from the selection register. The required spot checks shall be made by on-farm visits. Other farms may also be selected if the accuracy of the acreage report is questioned.

County Offices shall ensure that all required farms are flagged according to procedures in 2-CP before completing the options on the 2005 Farm Inspection Selection Menu.

Note: Ensure that late-filed farms and other required farms/crops are added during option 2.

There is **no** reason to select the following options:

- option 3, Final Selection Register
- option 4, Discrepancy Selection Register
- option 5, Print All Selected Farms.

C FSA 468

All County Offices shall prepare FSA-468's for all farms that have determined acreage. County Offices completing compliance according to subparagraph B (spot checking required farms only) may ignore discrepancy reports created during the FSA-468 processing.
