**Errors Encountered When Adding
National Agriculture Imagery Project (NAIP) Imagery to ArcView Projects**

1 Corrupted Image Files

A Background

The Help Desk and PECD have been receiving calls from State and County FSA IT users who are unable to add NAIP imagery to their ArcView projects. A segmentation error is occurring when corrupted image files in the geodata folder are added to other good imagery contained in an ArcView project.

The file corruption most likely occurs when the files are being copied to local servers over the network.

B Purpose

This notice:

- advises all imagery users, State IT and GIS Specialists/Coordinators, that a segmentation error will occur when corrupted imagery files are brought into an ArcView project
- recommends that all users of imagery test files transferred over the network by opening them in ArcView or ArcGis before incorporating them into an ArcView project to ensure that the files are not corrupt.

C State Office Action

State IT and GIS Specialists/Coordinators shall assist County Office imagery users in retrieving imagery over their servers if corruptions of this data continue to be a problem.
