1 Overview

A Background

On December 21, 2024, the President signed the American Relief Act, 2025 (Pub. L. 118-22) which includes a 1-year extension of the 2018 Farm Bill, reauthorizing CRP retroactively from October 1, 2024, through September 30, 2025.

Notice CRP-1036 restricted modifications and approvals of contracts (CRP-1) and cost share (C/S) agreements that resulted in an increase in contract acreage due to the lapse in authority.

B Purpose

This notice:

- reauthorizes CRP contract and C/S agreement modifications for existing CRP-1's approved before October 1, 2024, that require an increase in acres
- does **not** provide authority for County Offices and COC's to begin accepting new offers and approving new CRP-1's in FY 2025 under any signup type

Note: This authority will be provided in a forthcoming notice.

• provides authority to resume actions associated with DAFP relief approvals.

2 Action

A CRP-1 Modifications Allowed

This notice authorizes County Offices to make all routine modifications to CRP-1's, conservation plans, and C/S agreements as provided in 2-CRP, including cases that will result in an increase in CRP-1 acres.

State Office review of CRP-1 and FSA-848 modifications is no longer required.

B DAFP Relief Approvals

State Offices will resume actions associated with DAFP relief approvals.

- ensure County Offices follow the provisions of this notice

D County Office Action

County Offices will:
