**FY 2025 Soil Rental Rate (SRR) Update**

**1 Overview**

**A Background**

Notice CRP-1043 provided procedure for determining FY 2025 CRP SRR's. Alternative rate proposals submitted by States and CREP partners were considered in establishing the FY 2025 CRP SRR's.

The final FY 2025 CRP SRR's have been approved by DAFP.

**B Purpose**

This notice announces that FY 2025 CRP SRR's:

- will be updated and available on May 12, 2025, and effective for CRP offers on or after May 12, 2025
- will be updated in Conservation SDMS - CRP Soil Database Management System
- will be posted using SRR posting reports in the Conservation Online System (COLS)
- are not appealable.

**2 Updated SRR's**

**A Inflationary Adjustment**

In past signups, FSA increased the county rental rate for the life of the contract by a 10 percent inflationary adjustment that was factored into the SRR paid to the participant for all CRP enrollment types. In FY 2025, this inflationary adjustment will not be applied to the County Average Rental Rate (County AVGRT) for any CRP enrollment types.

**B Soil Productivity Index Range Adjustments**

The Soil Productivity Index (SPI) has been adjusted to include only 3 soil productivity groupings (0.5, 0.75, and 1.0) and is applied to the County AVGRT. The SPI is used in conjunction with NRCS' National Commodity Crop Productivity Index to align the county rental rate by soil productivity for each soil type. As a result, all SRR's have been updated, regardless of whether the associated county-average rates changed.

For soils with SPI:

- 1.00 or greater, the FY 2025 SRR will be the posted County AVGRT rate
- less than 1.00, the FY 2025 SRR will be the posted County AVGRT rate multiplied by the soil-specific SPI factor.

**C Calculating SRR**

The following table illustrates the SRR calculation after applying the statutory limitation and SPI for general CRP.

#### D Posting SRR and Effective Dates

The National Office will post the updated SRR's in Conservation SDMS on May 12, 2025. The FY 2025 CRP SRR's will be available on the FSA CRP statistics website at <https://www.fsa.usda.gov/tools/informational/reports/conservation-statistics/crp>.

**Note:** The FY 2025 SRR's will be effective for offers received beginning May 12, 2025.
