1 Overview

A

Background

During and shortly after signup 20, CRP data will be:

- uploaded on a weekly basis
- processed
- posted on the Intranet in text and graphic documents.

**Note:** This type of information was used during CRP Signup 18 to assist in the evaluation of program implementation.

B

Purpose

This notice provides:

- instructions on accessing CRP oversight information from the FSA Intranet
- an overview of the CRP oversight information that will be provided to State Offices
- a timeframe for accessing the FSA's Intranet site for CRP signup oversight information
- instructions on acquiring access to the FSA Intranet if FSA and NRCS State Offices are not collocated.

**Note:** The information in this notice is for **internal use only** and shall not be released to the public until a National press release is issued.

### 2 CRP Oversight Information on FSA Intranet

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#### A

##### Timeframe

Beginning February 4, 2000, State Offices shall access and download applicable new CRP oversight information according to subparagraph D.

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#### B

##### Accessing FSA Intranet Site

State Offices shall access the FSA Intranet site at <http://dc.ffasintranet.usda.gov/DAFP/cepdsto.htm>, using Netscape or Internet Explorer Internet browsers through Internet access accounts. See Exhibit 1 for an example of this screen.

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#### C

##### CRP Oversight Information

CEPD shall post the following information for State Offices:

- simple average of the EBI factor and subfactor scores
- number of CRP offers to date and the acreage offered as recorded in the system.

**Notes:** This information will be provided in the following formats:

- State maps by county
- reports with text information.

This information is scheduled to be updated once a week by COB Friday.

State Offices shall access and use this information according to subparagraph D.

**Note:** This site is not accessible to the public.

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#### D

##### State Office Action

On a weekly basis, State Offices shall:

- make a copy of the county-based maps and text documents
- provide a copy of the material to NRCS State Offices.

FSA, along with NRCS, shall review the data to assist in determining potential quality control problems. Unusual patterns or cross county consistency problems may become evident when reviewing the map data. If county consistency problems are evident on State maps, then FSA and NRCS State specialists shall:

- review EBI implementation for the applicable factor or subfactor
  - if necessary, ensure that proper corrective actions are taken.
