1 Generated CRP Report

Purpose

Software in County Release No. 455 will produce a report to identify which contracts were changed, if any, during the file edit with crop reductions on Marginal Pasture Land (MPL) contracts.

2-CRP, paragraph 196 provides that if the total of the AMTA contract acres and the CRP acres, **excluding** any marginal pasture land, including WBP noncropland or riparian buffers planted to trees, exceeds the agriculture use land for the farm, the producer must designate which acres to reduce. Therefore, since MPL is not considered cropland there should **not** be crop reductions associated with these contracts.

Action**

Conservation Program Technician shall inform tobacco and/or peanut Program Technician if any changes must be corrected in the tobacco or peanut files from the generated Report ID: EPCZ90-R001, if applicable.

Also, screens for crop reductions will no longer be displayed for contracts with 100 percent MPL enrolled for signups 14 and up.

Do not keep the report once it has been generated with no changes. If changes are needed for tobacco or peanut software, keep the report long enough to complete the necessary changes, but not longer than 30 calendar days.

Note: After the report has been printed, it is retained on hold. The spooled entries on hold will differ. S36 under PROC will display FAX322TC. AS400 under PROC will display FAX322T1. Use the applicable to reprint the report, if necessary. If not needed, cancel the print job.
