1 CREP Annual Performance Report (CEP-68R)

A Background

CREP was established, under CRP, to address specific recognized environmental issues of State and National importance. Forty-four Memoranda of Agreement (Agreement) have been signed with 33 States. Each Agreement provides that the State partner will provide a CREP Annual Performance Report (CEP-68R) to CEPD no later than a specified date indicated in the Agreement, usually 90 calendar days after the end of the Federal FY (September 30). The CREP Annual Performance Report (CEP-68R) is a critical tool used to:

- monitor program accomplishments
- justify average cost per acre of enrollment
- justify continued Federal and State CREP funding
- indicate continued State partner financial and administrative support
- detail CREP changes needed to ensure that CREP goals are achieved in a cost-effective manner.

Note: Each CREP Annual Performance Report (CEP-68R) **must** contain certain information, including a detailed monitoring report, according to FSA CRP National directives and the terms of the Agreement.

B Purpose

This notice:

- reminds FSA State Offices that FY 2010 CREP Annual Performance Reports (CEP-68R) are due according to the specific requirement in the Agreement and FSA CRP National directives
- requires a CREP Annual Performance Report (CEP-68R) for **each** CREP project on or before the applicable deadline
- requires that CREP Annual Performance Report (CEP-68R) address accomplishments in achieving each of the measurable program goals listed in the Agreement
- requires SED to ensure that a timely and detailed CREP Annual Performance Report (CEP-68R) is submitted to CEPD
- requires State Offices to provide applicable State government staff with relevant CREP enrollment and other data according to the terms of the Agreement and FSA CRP National directives
- requires an electronic copy of the CREP Annual Performance Report (CEP-68R) be e-mailed to Lana Nesbit, CREP Program Manager, at **lana.nesbit@wdc.usda.gov**.

Note: Failure to submit the CREP Annual Performance Report (CEP-68R) is in violation of the terms of the Agreement.

C State Office Action

- review the Agreement for the due date of the CREP Annual Performance Report (CEP-68R)
- inform the State contact of the due date
