

**2001 Idaho Oust Program (Oust Program)**

**1 Overview**

**A**

**Background**

The Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Administration, and Related Agencies Act of 2002 (Pub. L. 107-76) authorizes the Secretary to use not more than \$5 million of CCC funds to apply toward claims of crop damage, upon consultation with the Secretary of the Interior, that resulted from the Bureau of Land Management's (BLM) use of the herbicide Oust during the 2001 crop year in Idaho.

**B**

**Purpose**

This notice:

- provides policy and procedure for implementing the Oust Program
- instructs STC and COC's of determinations that must be made before signup
- provides instructions for the application process.

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## Notice DAP-133

### 2 General Provisions

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#### A

##### **Program Funding**

Funding for the Oust Program is limited to \$5 million. If the total calculated value of eligible Oust applications exceeds the available funding, a national payment factor will be applied to payments issued to eligible producers.

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#### B

##### **Administrative Offset**

Payments under the Oust Program shall be issued without regard to administrative offset.

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#### C

##### **Gross Revenue and Payment Limitations**

There are no gross revenue or per “person” payment limitations under the Oust Program. Therefore, CCC-502 and CCC-562 are not required to be filed for producers to receive payments under the Oust Program.

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#### D

##### **HELC/WC Provisions**

As a condition to receive Oust benefits, a producer must have been in compliance with the HELC/WC provisions of 7 CFR Part 12 for the 2001 year.

Before payments are made, producers must:

- have AD-1026 on file, certifying compliance with HELC/WC provisions
  - meet applicable requirements in 6-CP.

### 3 Program Provisions

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#### A

##### Application Period

STC shall determine the beginning signup date for the Oust Program. The application deadline will also be determined by STC. However, that date shall **not** be established until the regulation is published. STC will be notified at that time.

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#### B

##### Means of Application

CCC-559 must be submitted by the applicant, **by field**, to the County Office where the land is administratively located. The producer must file 1 application for each field.

Instructions for completing CCC-559 and an example of CCC-559 are in Exhibit 1.

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#### C

##### Payment Structure

Oust payments shall be based on the total eligible acres by field and the producer's share of the crop or crop proceeds, or if no crop was produced, the share the producer would have received if the crop had been produced.

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#### D

##### Loss Threshold

Oust benefits will be determined by field. Producers are eligible for Oust benefits when qualifying losses exceed 25 percent of the expected production for the crop on the field.

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#### E

##### Payment Rates and Yields

Oust Program payment rates and yields are the payment rates and yields used for the 2000 Crop Disaster Program (CDP) for the applicable crop.

**Note:** Producer's historical yields will not be used for determining payment yields.

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#### F

##### Payment Formula

Oust benefits shall be made in an amount determined by multiplying 75 percent of the loss of production in excess of 25 percent of the expected production on eligible acreage on a field by the applicable crop payment rate.

### 4 Eligibility Provisions

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#### A

##### Definition of Eligible Crops

Eligible crops are crops planted in the 2001 crop year in Idaho that suffered damage because of Oust being sprayed on BLM rangeland.

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#### B

##### Eligible Cause of Loss

Oust payment provisions apply if crop production was adversely affected by using Oust on BLM rangeland during the 2001 crop year in Idaho.

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#### C

##### Ineligible Causes of Loss

Losses resulting from anything other than BLM's use of Oust are an ineligible cause of loss under the Oust Program. Eligible causes of loss cannot be the result of adverse weather conditions, poor management decisions, or poor farming practices.

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#### D

##### Eligible Acreage

Eligible acreage for a crop shall be calculated using the number of acres shown to have been planted to a crop on a field as provided on the applicable FSA-578 or FSA-578D's filed by the producer, excluding acreage enrolled by the producer in the 2001 Sugar Payment-in-Kind Diversion Program.

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#### E

##### Documenting Oust-Affected Crop

To receive Oust benefits, COC must determine that because of Oust, the producer sustained a loss in production of a crop.

To determine eligible acreage (subparagraph D) was damaged by Oust, the producer must provide 1 of the following documentation:

- field inspection form compiled by a licensed crop consultant
- documentation from an independent crop consultant that indicates Oust damage
- positive soil test results that show the presence of Oust in the sample
- documentation from a University of Idaho Specialist that the acreage showed Oust damage.

CCC-559 shall **not** be approved without acceptable documentation substantiating the crop was affected by Oust.

### 5 Production

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#### A Expected Production

STC shall develop procedure and provide instructions to County Offices for determining each field's expected production.

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#### B Actual Production

Actual production includes harvested, appraised, and assigned. STC shall develop procedure and provide instructions to County Offices for:

- assigning actual production to each field that does not have acceptable production evidence by field
  - accepting actual acceptable production records that document field-by-field production.

### 6 Application Processing

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#### A Complete Application

Applications must be filed on a field-by-field basis. One application shall be filed for each field for each producer on the farm.

A complete application includes the following:

- completed CCC-559
  - AD-1026
  - FSA-578 or FSA-578D
  - acceptable production evidence outlined in paragraph 5
  - acceptable documentation substantiating the crop was affected by Oust as provided in subparagraph 4 E.

### 6 Application Processing (Continued)

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#### B

##### **CCC-559 Automated Application System**

Applicants must complete an application, **by field**, in the County Office where the land is administratively located.

In a forthcoming notice, County Offices will be provided with the CCC-559 Automated Application System to generate automated CCC-559's and CCC-559A's.

Instructions for completing CCC-559A and an example of CCC-559A are in Exhibit 2.

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#### C

##### **Application Approval**

COC shall review applications and required documentation to take the appropriate action to either approve or disapprove the applicant for program benefits.

If COC determines the application should be disapproved, County Offices shall immediately notify the producer of the disapproval. The letter to the producer shall include the following:

- notification that the Oust application was disapproved
  - reason or reasons for the disapproval
  - applicable appeal rights according to 1-APP.

#### D

##### **Payment Authorization**

After the ending date of the application period, County Offices shall provide the National Office with application data to determine a national payment factor for Oust Program benefits. Instructions for providing application data to the National Office will be provided in a future notice. Program benefits will be calculated and payments will be issued by direct deposit through KCFO.

### 7 Required Action

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#### **A STC Responsibilities**

As soon as possible, STC shall:

- determine and announce the beginning signup date
  - provide guidelines to COC for determining expected, actual, and assigned production on a field-by-field basis
  - ensure that County Offices follow the provisions of this notice.
- 

#### **B COC Responsibilities**

COC shall immediately:

- publicize the contents of this notice
  - determine expected, actual, and assigned production on a field-by-field basis according to guidelines provided by STC
  - verify that potential Oust producers are in the 2001 name and address file. If a producer does not exist in the name and address file, the producer must be added to the name and address file through the Service Center Information Management System according to 1-CM.
