**1 Overview**

**A**

**Background**

Notice DAP-130 advised State and County Offices:

- that 1999 and 2000 QLP-AP payment processing would be permanently disabled on April 5, 2002
- to request QLP-AP payment authorization codes from PECD, Compliance Branch
- to transmit QLP-AP relief cases to DAFP.

**B**

**Purpose**

This notice:

- instructs State and County Offices to request 1999 and 2000 QLP-AP payment authorizations and request for relief **by July 8, 2002**
- advises State and County Offices that all software options will be disabled on **July 12, 2002.**

## Notice DAP-134

### 2 QLP-AP Payment Authorization Codes and Requests for Relief

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#### A

**Deadline for Authorization Codes** Requests for 1999 and 2000 QLP-AP payment authorization codes and/or request for relief must be received by **COB July 8, 2002**. Instructions for requesting relief and payment authorization codes were outlined in notice DAP-130.

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#### B

**Appeal Cases** QLP-AP payments resulting from appeal cases after July 8, 2002, will be handled on a case-by-case basis. State Offices shall request QLP-AP payment authorization codes, resulting from appeal cases, from PECD, Compliance Branch, by FAX at 202-720-4941.

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### 3 Software Modifications

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#### A

**Application Processing Option** The software to disable 1999 and 2000 QLP-AP application processing options will be included in County Release No. 489, scheduled to arrive in County Offices by July 12, 2002.

County Offices shall ensure that **all** application data for 1999 and 2000 QLP-AP is loaded in the system by COB, July 8, 2002. This includes applications that:

- are in appeal status
  - were filed on a manual application and have not been loaded in the system
  - have been disapproved by COC.
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## Notice DAP-134

### 4 Action

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#### A County Office Action

County Offices shall:

- load all 1999 and 2000 QLP-AP application data in the system **by July 12, 2002**
- ensure that an “**all**” overpayment process is computed **before** County Release No. 489 is installed
- ensure that overpayment registers are thoroughly reviewed and either of the following actions are taken:
  - legitimate overpayments are transferred to CRS immediately
  - conditions causing the overpayment to be listed are immediately corrected.

**Note:** 3-DAP, paragraph 315 specifies that overpayments shall be calculated for **all** producers at least once every 60 calendar days.

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#### B State Office Action

State Offices shall:

- request 1999 and 2000 QLP-AP payment authorization codes and requests for relief by **July 8, 2002**
  - request 1999 and 2000 QLP-AP payment authorization codes, resulting from appeal cases after July 8, 2002, from PECD on a case-by-case basis.
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
