**New Data for the Crop Disaster Program (CDP) Linkage Noncompliance Report**

**1 New Data Download**

**A Background**

Notice DAP-204 provided instructions to County Offices for printing the CDP Linkage Noncompliance Report for 2001 and 2002 CDP participants. The report was to generate a list of producers for whom:

- RMA has no record of 2003 or 2004 crop insurance at a level greater than CAT level being purchased on the crop receiving a disaster benefit
- NAP has no record of 2003 or 2004 NAP coverage being purchased on the crop receiving a disaster benefit.

Unfortunately, RMA provided the wrong crop insurance data for the report. The data for the report showed that the only producers who were out of compliance with linkage requirements are producers that purchased less than CAT level coverage. The report should have included producers who purchased CAT level coverage as being out of compliance with linkage requirements.

RMA has provided new data which has been downloaded to County Offices and is available for use as of Monday, January 24.

**B Purpose**

This notice provides instructions for County Offices to identify and send notification letters to additional producers determined to be out of compliance with linkage requirements for 2003 and 2004 crop years.

### 1 New Data Download (Continued)

#### C County Office Action

Upon receipt of the new RMA data, County Offices shall:

- rerun the CDP Linkage Noncompliance Report according to Notice DAP-204
- annotate the producers who have already been notified that they did not meet the linkage requirements
- annotate the producers who appear on the report but are in compliance with linkage requirements according to Notice DAP-204, subparagraph 2 A
- determine the producers who have not been sent a notification letter informing them of their linkage requirements and the lack of a record indicating insurance or NAP coverage was purchased for 2003 and 2004 crop years
- mail each additional producer a notification letter according to Notice DAP-204, subparagraph 2 D.

The notification letters shall be mailed by February 18.
