**Determining Payment Reductions for 2005-2007 Livestock Indemnity  
Program (LIP) and Livestock Compensation Program (LCP)**

**1 Overview**

**A Background**

Title IX of the U.S. Troop Readiness, Veterans' Care, Katrina Recovery, and Iraq Accountability Appropriations Act of 2007 provides that payments for:

- LCP be reduced by any amount received by the producer for the same loss or any similar loss under the 2006 Livestock Assistance Grant Program (LAGP)
- LIP be reduced by any amount received by the producer for the same loss or any similar loss under the 2005 Aquaculture Grant Program (AGP).

LAGP provided \$50 million in assistance to certain livestock producers affected by exceptional drought from March through August 2006. AGP provided \$25 million in assistance to aquaculture producers adversely affected by the 2005 hurricane season. Both LAGP and AGP were administered through block grants to State Offices, designated by the Governor of those States.

**B Purpose**

This notice provides State and County Offices with the web site that lists LAGP and AGP payment data by State.

### 2 Action

#### A County Office Action

County Offices shall:

- take the following steps to find a list of LAGP and AGP payment data in their respective State

Step	Action
1	Visit the FSA Intranet at <a href="http://intranet.fsa.usda.gov/fsa">http://intranet.fsa.usda.gov/fsa</a> .
2	Under the “In the Spotlight” portion of the web site, click on “2006 Livestock Assistance Grant Program and 2005 Aquaculture Grant Program Payments Listed by State”.
3	At the bottom of the screen, click on either of the following options: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• “2006 Livestock Assistance Grant Program Payments”</li><li>• “2005 Aquaculture Grant Program Payments”.</li></ul>
4	After the file is opened, click on the appropriate State tab at the bottom of the screen.

**Note:** Some State lists provide more detailed data than others. However, at a minimum, each State’s list will provide the producer’s name, last 4 digits of the producer’s tax identification number, and payment amount.

- use data provided to enter payment reductions in the LIP and LCP application software according to the following references in 4-DAP (Rev. 2):
  - subparagraph 103 C for LIP
  - subparagraph 203 C for LCP.
