1 Overview

A Background

The U.S. Troop Readiness, Veterans' Care, Katrina Recovery, and Iraq Accountability Appropriations Act, 2007 authorizes payments to be issued for 2005, 2006, and 2007 crop disaster losses.

Notice DAP-257 instructed State Offices to data load crop data for CDP into the 2007 National Crop Table (NCT).

Notice DAP-264 advised State Offices that September 27, 2007, was the date for NCT records to be captured to establish the initial records for the 2005/2006/2007 CDP Crop Table.

B Purpose

This notice provides the following information for State Offices:

- procedure to load crop data using the CDP crop table
- notification that they can access the CDP crop table beginning **October 9, 2007**.

1 Overview (Continued)

C 2007 NCT Records

All records data loaded into the 2007 NCT by COB September 27, 2007, using the instructions in Notice DAP-257, were used to create the initial records for the CDP crop table. All records that passed the validations were updated and will be downloaded to the counties without any intervention by State Office users. Those records that could not be updated can be identified by the modified records report according to subparagraph 6 C.

Note: All historical yield and price data in NCT was moved to the CDP crop table. The “Current Yield” and “Current Price” data was not moved; therefore, if the yield or price was overridden in NCT, the histories reflecting those yields and prices **must** be loaded into the CDP crop table.

2 CDP Crop Table

A General

The CDP crop table is a web-based software application.

When moving through the CDP web pages, **only** navigate using the back and previous screen options available on the page. Do **not** use the browser navigation buttons.

B Security

Only State Office users, or those County Office users for whom the State Office provides authorization, will be able to add or change records. The same users authorized for NCT will be authorized for the CDP crop table.

If additional users should be granted CDP crop table update authority, the State Office shall submit a completed FSA-13-A according to instructions on the form.



2	<p>Under "Production Adjustment & Disaster Programs", click on "2005-2006-2007 CDP Crop Table". The following screen will be displayed.</p> <div data-bbox="391 688 1490 1335" style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 10px;"> <p>The purpose of this process is to create a table for the administration of the 05/06/07 Crop Disaster Program.</p> <p>The State Offices will enter all pertinent data, including the price and yield. The counties can view, but not enter or modify any data. The STO can add, modify or delete any record at any time. The records will be downloaded daily to the counties. 

B CDP Crop Table Main Menu

Once a user is logged in and has been authenticated, the CDP Crop Table Main Menu will be displayed. From this page, users will select to:

- add new records or update existing records on the CDP crop table
- search or modify existing records
- create reports.




Note: The 2005, 2006, and 2007 crop table records are all added or updated through the same option.

4 Adding a Record

A Selecting Crop

After selecting “Add/Update a CDP Record” from the CDP Crop Table Main Menu, the Add/Update Crop Record Screen will be displayed. Users can load a new record or update information for an incomplete record.



Select the crop for which crop data will be entered according to the following table.

Field/Button	Action
State	Select the State from the drop-down list.
Crop	Select the crop from the drop-down list. See 2-CP, Exhibit 10.5 for crops.
Crop Type	If the selected crop has multiple types, select the crop type from the drop-down list. See 2-CP, Exhibit 10.5 for the crop types.
Intended Use	If the selected crop has an intended use, select the intended use from the drop-down list. See 2-CP: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Exhibit 11 for intended uses Exhibit 10.5 for intended uses specific to the selected crop

B CDP State Crop Information

After the user selects the crop for which data will be added, the software will review existing records on the CDP crop table to determine if the crop, crop type, and intended use already exist on the CDP crop table for any county within the State. If no match is found, the unit of measure, prevented planted factor, unharvested factor, and price data must be entered. The following screen will be displayed.




