**Disabling 2005 Supplemental Hurricane Disaster Program Payment Processing**

**1 Overview**

**A Background**

The Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act for Defense, the Global War on Terror, and Hurricane Recovery 2006 (Pub. L. 109-234), authorized the Secretary of Agriculture to provide assistance to producers who suffered losses because of the 2005 Hurricanes Katrina, Ophelia, Rita, and Wilma. The Act also authorized the 2005 Supplemental Hurricane Program Payments for the Citrus Program (CP), Nursery Program (NP), Livestock Indemnity Program II (LIP II), and Livestock Compensation Program (LCP).

The 2005 Supplemental Hurricane Programs payment and overpayment processes use supporting files to determine whether a producer has been underpaid or overpaid. Because some of the supporting files only maintain data for the most current 3 years, some of the:

- outstanding payments **cannot** be processed because the supporting files **cannot** be updated
- producers may be listed on the overpayment register that are **not** actually overpaid.

### 1 Overview (Continued)

#### B Purpose

This notice informs State and County Offices that:

- the following 2005 Supplemental Hurricane Program payment and overpayment processing options will be disabled after installing County Release No. 687:
  - Citrus Program
  - Nursery Program
  - Livestock Indemnity Program II
  - Livestock Compensation Program

**Note:** The PPH and Estimated Calculated Payment Report processing will remain available after installing County Release No. 687.

- they will be required to submit documentation to the National Office where a 2005 Supplemental Hurricane Program Payment was earned by the producer, but **not** issued.

### 2 Action

#### A State Office Action

State Offices shall:

- ensure that County Offices are informed of the contents of this notice

**Note:** Requests **must** be accompanied by a statement from the DD explaining why the County Office was unable to process payments.

### 2 Action (Continued)

#### B County Office Action

County Offices shall:

- ensure that County Release No. 687 is installed upon receipt
- submit the following documentation, for the applicable program, to the State Office for any 2005 Supplemental Hurricane Program payment that was **not** issued:
  - explanation about why the 2005 Supplemental Program payment was not issued
  - CCC-552 CITRUS, CCC-552 NURSERY, CCC-897 (LIP II), or CCC-898 (LCP)
  - Estimated Calculated Payment Report
  - Producer Payment History (PPH)

**Reminders:** If the producer is a joint operation, a PPH **must** be submitted for each member of the joint operation.

PPH **must** be submitted for each combined producer, if applicable.

**Note:** PPH shall be printed by selecting the applicable menu options from the enabled payment report menu. An accounting history print or transaction statement will **not** be accepted in place of PPH from the payment reports menu.

- MABDIG for the year closest to the payment year being requested for the following:
  - producer
  - affected member of the joint operation.
