**1 Overview**

**A Background**

The Farm Security and Rural Investment Act of 2002 prohibits, in some situations, the planting of FAV's and wild rice on base acres enrolled in DCP. However, producers may plant FAV's and wild rice on base acres enrolled in DCP:

- in a double-cropping practice with covered commodities or peanuts in any region designated as having a history of double-cropping covered commodities or peanuts with FAV's or wild rice as provided in 1-DCP, paragraph 473
- on a farm with a history of planting FAV's or wild rice, except that direct and counter-cyclical payments shall be reduced by an acre for each acre of base acreage planted to FAV or wild rice as provided in 1-DCP, paragraph 475
- if the producer has an established history of planting a specific FAV or wild rice, except that direct and counter-cyclical payments shall be reduced by an acre for each acre of base acreage planted to FAV or wild rice as provided in 1-DCP, paragraph 477.

Failure to comply with FAV and wild rice provisions shall result in DCP contract termination or a reduction in DCP payments according to 4-CP.

## Notice DCP-106

### 1 Overview (Continued)

#### A Background (Continued)

Notice DCP-102 and 4-CP, paragraph 65, provided County Offices with FAV queries that may be used to assist County Offices in determining whether FAV's or wild rice are planted on base acres.

Queries and procedure for accessing the queries were provided in Information Bulletin Nos. 2830 and 2866. However, the queries previously provided did not include wild rice acreage. In addition, the queries were not always capturing both irrigated and nonirrigated acreage on the farm.

#### B Purpose

This notice provides County Offices:

- 6 modified FAV and wild rice queries that will be included in a forthcoming Information Bulletin
- detailed descriptions of the six FAV and wild rice queries
- procedure on accessing the 6 modified queries
- procedure for using the queries as a tool to determine the number of DCP base acres planted to FAV's or wild rice
- determinations that County Offices must make with respect to exceptions to planted FAV or wild rice on DCP base acres.

#### C Notification to County Offices

State Offices shall immediately notify and send County Offices the content of this notice.

### 2 FAV Query Descriptions

#### A FAV Queries

A forthcoming Information Bulletin will provide the following 6 modified queries.

FAVSMD31	2003 Summary of Determined FAV Acreage

The 6 queries in this subparagraph have been developed to assist County Offices in accurately calculating the number of DCP base acres planted to FAV's or wild rice. All 6 queries must be used by County Offices as instructed in this notice to accurately determine:

- number of DCP base acres planted to FAV's or wild rice
- acre-for-acre reduction to be entered in the FAVpayment reduction software.

**Note:** Although the query names do not include wild rice, the queries have been modified to include the applicable wild rice acreage.

**2 FAV Query Descriptions (Continued)**

**B FAVRP3A1**

Query FAVRP3A1, 2003 FAV's Reported Planted on DCP Base Acreage-Nonbase Acres Zero or Greater, will provide a list of farms that meet both of the following:

- amount of nonbase acres for the farm is zero or greater
- reported FAV or wild rice planted acreage exceeds the nonbase acres for the farm.

**Note:** The amount of nonbase acres for a farm is calculated by subtracting the farm's total DCP base acres from the farm's total effective DCP cropland.

**Important:** The query provides all FAV and wild rice acreage reported as planted by the producer. In some situations, not all planted FAV and wild rice acreage should be counted for compliance purposes.

This query is based on the total FAV and wild rice acreage planted on the farm as **reported** by the producer. Following is a description of each field provided by query FAVRP3A1.

**C FAVRP3B1**

Query FAVRP3B1, 2003 FAV's Reported Planted on DCP Base Acreage-Nonbase Less Than Zero, will provide a list of farms that meet both of the following:

- the amount of nonbase acres for the farm is zero
- reported FAV or wild rice planted acreage on the farm.

**Note:** The amount of nonbase acres for a farm is calculated by subtracting the total DCP base acres for the farm from the farm's total effective DCP cropland.

**Important:** The query provides all FAV and wild rice acreage reported as planted by the producer. In some situations, not all planted FAV and wild rice acreage should be counted for compliance purposes.

This query is based on the total FAV and wild rice acreage planted on the farm as **reported** by the producer. Following is a description of each field provided by query FAVRP3B1.

Base Acreage	Farm's base acreage as provided in the farm file, A.MI.FTM.

**D FAVDT3A1**

Query FAVDT3A1, 2003 FAV's Determined Planted on DCP Base Acreage-Nonbase Acres Zero or Greater, will provide a list of farms that meet both of the following:

- amount of nonbase acres for the farm is zero or greater
- determined FAV or wild rice planted acreage exceeds the nonbase acres for the farm.

**Note:** The amount of nonbase acres for a farm is calculated by subtracting the farm's total DCP base acres from the farm's total effective DCP cropland.

**Important:** The query provides all planted FAV and wild rice acreage recorded as determined in the FSA-578 software. In some situations, not all FAV and wild rice acreage should be counted for compliance purposes.

This query is based on the total FAV and wild rice **determined** acreage on the farm. Following is a description of each field provided by query FAVDT3A1.

**E FAVDT3B1**

Query FAVDT3B1, 2003 FAV's Determined Planted on DCP Base Acreage - Nonbase Acres Less Than Zero, will provide a list of farms that meet both of the following:

- the amount of nonbase acres for the farm is less than zero
- there are determined FAV or wild rice planted acres on the farm.

**Note:** The amount of nonbase acres for a farm is calculated by subtracting the farm's total DCP base acres from the farm's total effective DCP cropland.

**Important:** The query provides all planted FAV and wild rice acreage recorded as determined in the FSA-578 software. In some situations, not all planted FAV and wild rice acreage should be counted for compliance purposes.

This query is based on the total FAV and wild rice acreage planted on the farm as **determined** by a spot check. Following is a description of each field provided by query FAVDT3B1.

**F FAVSMR31**

Query FAVSMR31, 2003 FAV Summary of Reported Acreage, will provide FAV and wild rice acreage **reported** by the producer as summarized in the FSA-578 Summary File, A.ME.S3M. This query will provide the total FAV and wild rice acreage on the farm that is reported as planted, double cropped, failed, prevented, experimental, or intended. Following is a description of each field provided by query FAVSMR31.

**Note:** FAV and wild rice records will be listed separately. Irrigated and nonirrigated records will be listed separately.

<b>Name</b>	<b>Description</b>
Farm Number	Farm number.
Crop Code	OFAV crop code of "773" or wild rice crop code of "641".
Prac Code	"I" for irrigated or "N" for nonirrigated.
Planted Acreage - Rpt	The number of FAV and wild rice acres on the farm that were reported as planted.
Dbl Pgm Crop Acre - Rpt	The FAV and wild rice acreage on the farm reported by the producer as being double-cropped.
Failed Acreage - Rpt	The FAV and wild rice acreage on the farm reported by the producer as failed.
Prevented Plnt Acr - Rpt	The FAV and wild rice acreage on the farm that the producer reported as prevented planted.
Experimental Acreage - Reported	The FAV and wild rice acreage on the farm reported by the producer as experimental.
Intended Acreage - Rpt	The FAV and wild rice acreage reported by the producer that they intend to plant but did not.

**2 FAV Query Descriptions (Continued)**

**G FAVSMD31**

Query FAVSMD31, 2003 FAV Summary of Determined Acreage, will provide FAV and wild rice **determined** acreage as summarized in the FSA-578 Summary File, A.ME.S3M. This query will provide the total FAV and wild rice acreage on the farm that is determined by a spot check to be planted, double-cropped, failed, prevented, experimental, or intended. Following is a description of each field provided by query FAVSMD31.

**Note:** FAV and wild rice records will be listed separately. Irrigated and nonirrigated records will be listed separately.

Name	Description
Farm Number	Farm number.
Crop Code	OFAV crop code of "773" or wild rice crop code of "641".
Prac Code	"I" for irrigated or "N" for nonirrigated.
Planted Acreage - Det	The number of FAV and wild rice acres on the farm that were determined by a spot check as planted.
Dbl Pgm Crop Acre - Det	The FAV and wild rice double-cropped acreage on the farm determined by a spot check.
Failed Acreage - Det	The FAV and wild rice failed acreage on the farm determined by a spot check as failed.
Prevented Plnt Acre - Det	The FAV and wild rice prevented planted acreage on the farm determined by a spot check.
Experimental Acreage - Det	The FAV and wild rice experimental acreage on the farm determined by a spot check.
Intended Acreage - Det	The FAV and wild rice acreage determined by a spot check as intended to plant but did not.

### 3 FAV and Wild Rice Query Exceptions

#### A Double Cropping Region Exception

FAV's and wild rice may be planted on base acres enrolled in DCP without violation or acre-for-acre payment reduction if FAV or wild rice, as applicable, is planted in a double-cropping cycle with a covered commodity or peanuts planted in a designated FAV double-cropping region established by STC. See 1-DCP, paragraph 473.

The FAV queries do not recognize FAV double-cropping regions. Therefore, County Offices must manually determine whether:

- farm is administratively located in an approved FAV double-cropping region
- FAV or wild rice is double-cropped with a covered commodity or peanuts on the same acreage in a 12-month period
- the requirements in 1-DCP, paragraph 473 are met.

If all the criteria in this subparagraph are met, County Offices must subtract the FAV and wild rice acreage that is double-cropped with a covered commodity or peanuts from the "Planted Acreage" and "Excess FAV" columns on queries FAVRP3A1, FAVRP3B1, FAVDT3A1, or FAVDT3B1, as applicable.

#### B Multiple FAV's on Same Acreage in Same FY

As provided in 1-DCP, paragraph 471, multiple plantings of any FAV on the same acreage in a FY shall be considered only once for compliance purposes. Therefore, if a farm has multiple plantings of any FAV or wild rice on the same acreage in a fiscal year, the County Office must subtract the applicable acreage from the "Planted Acreage" and "Excess FAV" columns on queries FAVRP3A1, FAVRP3B1, FAVDT3A1, or FAVDT3B1, as applicable.

#### C Experimental FAV Acreage

FAV's that were planted for experimental purposes shall be considered for FAV and wild rice compliance purposes. However, experimental FAV acreage is not included in the "Planted Acreage" and "Excess FAV" columns on queries FAVRP3A1, FAVRP3B1, FAVDT3A1, or FAVDT3B1. Therefore, experimental FAV and wild rice acreage, provided on queries FAVSMR31 and FAVSMD31, must be added to the "Planted Acreage" and "Excess FAV" columns on the applicable queries.

### 4 Accessing Modified Queries

#### A Procedure

The modified FAV and wild rice queries shall be accessed using the instructions in this table.

## Notice DCP-106

### 5 Using Queries FAVRP3A1/FAVRP3B1 and FAVDT3A1/FAVDT3B1

#### A Purpose

The queries described in this notice are only to be used by County Offices as a tool in determining FAV and wild rice acreage planted on base acres and acre-for-acre reduction amounts.

#### B Reported FAV Acreage

Queries FAVRP3A1 and FAVRP3B1 use **reported** FAV and wild rice acreage. If a farm has determined FAV or wild rice acreage, the determined acreage shall be used in calculating the number of FAV and wild rice acres planted on base acres. Therefore, queries FAVRP3A1 and FAVRP3B1 shall be used for farms that do not have any determined FAV or wild rice acreage.

Query FAVRP3A1 provides farms with:

- FAV's or wild rice planted on base acres
- nonbase acreage greater than or equal to zero.

Query FAVRP3B1 provides farms with:

- FAV's or wild rice planted on base acres
- nonbase acreage less than zero.

#### C Determined FAV Acreage

Queries FAVDT3A1 and FAVDT3B1 shall be used for farms with determined FAV or wild rice acreage.

Query FAVDT3A1 provides farms with:

- FAV's or wild rice planted on base acres
- nonbase acreage greater than or equal to zero.

Query FAVDT3B1 provides farms with:

- FAV's or wild rice planted on base acres
- nonbase acreage less than zero.

### 5 Using Queries FAVRP3A1/FAVRP3B1 and FAVDT3A1/FAVDT3B1 (Continued)

#### D FAV's Planted on DCP Base Acres

On queries FAVRP3A1, FAVRP3B1, FAVDT3A1, and FAVDT3B1 the column titled "Planted Acreage" includes the following FAV and wild rice reported or determined acreage, as applicable:

- initial
- subsequent
- double-cropped
- repeat
- failed.

Therefore, the result in the "Excess FAV" column (effective DCP cropland minus base acreage) may **not** be the final FAV and wild rice acreage planted on base acres enrolled in DCP to be entered in the compliance software for acre-for-acre reductions. County Offices must use all queries as described in this notice to determine the final FAV and wild rice acreage to be entered in the compliance software for acre-for-acre reductions.

### 6 Using Queries FAVSMR31 and FAVSMD31

#### A Purpose

Queries FAVSMR31 and FAVSMD31 were developed to indicate how certain FAV and wild rice acreage was recorded in the FSA-578 software to help County Offices in determining which acreage should be added or subtracted from the "planted acreage" and "Excess FAV" columns on specific queries, as applicable.

**Note:** Query FAVSMR31 is based on reported FAV acreage. FAVSMD31 is based on determined FAV acreage.

**7 Required Action**

**A County Office Action**

The following table provides FAV and wild rice scenarios and the applicable County Office action that must be taken to accurately determining DCP acre-for-acre reductions.

### 7 Required Action (Continued)

#### A County Office Action (Continued)

The “Planted Acreage” column of the FAV and wild rice queries include FAV’s and wild rice reported or determined, as applicable, with either of the following crop status codes:

- “R” for repeat crops
- “S” for subsequent crops.

FAV’s and wild rice acreage that meet the requirements to have a crop status code of “R” **shall** not be considered for FAV and wild rice compliance purposes according to 1-DCP, paragraph 471.

FAV’s and wild rice acreage that meet the requirements to have a crop status code of “S” **may** not be considered for FAV and wild rice compliance purposes according to 1-DCP, paragraph 471.

Subtract the applicable acreage from the “Planted Acreage” and “Excess FAV” columns on queries FAVRP3A1, FAVRP3B1, FAVDT3A1, or FAVDT3B1, as applicable, if FAV’s or wild rice is recorded in the FSA-578 software with either a crop status code of:

- “R” that meets the requirements of a repeat crop
- “S” that meets the requirements of a subsequent crop and the initial crop is another FAV or wild rice.

**Note:** No action is required for that amount if the initial crop is any crop other than FAV or wild rice. See paragraph 8, farm 170 example.

**8 Examples**

**A Examples of How to Use FAV and Wild Rice Queries To Determine Acre-for-Acre Reductions**

Exhibit 1 provides an example of the 6 queries. The following table provides an explanation for 3 farms on the queries and how to use the queries to accurately determine DCP acre-for-acre reductions. Exhibit 2 provides FSA-578's for the 3 farms provided in the following table.

<b>Farm</b>	<b>Situation</b>	<b>Action</b>
455	<p>Farm 455 has 294.8 acres of effective DCP cropland and 281.5 base acres. Therefore, farm 455 has 13.3 free acres.
