2004 Fruit and Vegetable (FAV) and Wild Rice (WR) Queries

Approved by: Acting Deputy Administrator, Farm Programs



1 Overview

A Background

The Farm Security and Rural Investment Act of 2002 prohibits, in some situations, the planting of FAV's and WR on base acres enrolled in DCP. However, producers may plant FAV's and WR on base acres enrolled in DCP:

- in a double-cropping practice with covered commodities or peanuts in any region designated as having a history of double-cropping covered commodities or peanuts with FAV's or WR as provided in 1-DCP, paragraph 473
- on a farm with a history of planting FAV's or WR, except that direct and counter-cyclical payments shall be reduced by an acre for each acre of base acreage planted to FAV or WR as provided in 1-DCP, paragraph 475
- if the producer has an established history of planting a specific FAV or WR, except that direct and counter-cyclical payments shall be reduced by an acre for each acre of base acreage planted to FAV or WR as provided in 1-DCP, paragraph 477.

Failure to comply with FAV and WR provisions shall result in DCP contract termination or a reduction in DCP payments according to 4-CP.

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1 Overview (Continued)

B FAV/WR Planting Violations

This notice does not address FAV/WR acreage subject to planting violations. The FAV/WR queries cannot be used to determine planting violation acreage.

C Purpose

This notice provides County Offices:

- 3 FAV and WR queries that will be included in Information Bulletin No. 3138
- instruction for calculations if a farm has some FAV's with determined acres and some FAV's with only reported acres
- detailed descriptions of the 3 FAV and WR queries
- procedure on accessing the three queries
- procedure for using the queries as a tool to determine the number of DCP base acres planted to FAV's or WR
- determinations that County Offices must make with respect to exceptions to FAV or WR planted on DCP base acres
- procedure for farms that have horseradish acreage
- instruction to rerun FAV and WR queries after spot checks have been completed and determined acreage has been loaded in the acreage reporting software, if applicable.

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2 2004 FAV/WR Query Descriptions

A 2004 FAV/WR Queries

Information Bulletin No. 3138 will provide the following 3 queries.

FAV Query	Title
FAVRP4A1	2004 FAV's on Base Acres - Nonbase Acres Equal To or Greater Than Zero
FAVRP4B1	2004 FAV's on Base Acres - Nonbase Acres Less Than Zero
FAVSMR41	2004 Summary of Reported or Determined FAV/WR Acreage

These 3 queries have been developed as a tool to assist the County Office in accurately calculating the number of DCP base acres planted to FAV's or WR. All 3 queries must be used by the County Office as instructed in this notice to accurately determine:

- number of DCP base acres planted to FAV's or WR
- acre-for-acre reduction to be entered in the FAV Payment Reduction Software.

Note: In 2003, the 6 FAV/WR queries listed farms with determined acreage on separate queries from farms with reported acreage. However, the 2004 queries list farms with determined and/or reported acreage on the same queries. Farms with determined FAV/WR acreage will be flagged with a "1" in the "Determined Acres Used" column. Farms with reported FAV/WR acreage will be indicated with a "0" in the "Determined Acres Used" column.

Important: If a farm has some FAV's with determined acres and some FAV's with only reported acres, the query is not picking up the crops having only reported acres. Therefore, the planted FAV acreage must be manually calculated. In this case, the County Office shall follow procedure in subparagraph 3 D to determine FAV/WR acreage planted on base acres to be entered in the compliance software for acre-for-acre reductions.

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2 2004 FAV/WR Query Descriptions (Continued)

B Query FAVRP4A1

Query FAVRP4A1, 2004 FAV's on Base Acres-Nonbase Acres Equal To or Greater Than Zero, will provide a list of farms that meet both of the following:

- amount of non-base acres for the farm is equal to or greater than zero
- reported or determined FAV or WR planted acreage exceeds the non-base acres for the farm.

FAV and WR records will be listed separately. Irrigated and nonirrigated records will be listed separately.

Note: The amount of nonbase acres for a farm is calculated by subtracting the farm's total DCP base acres from the farm's total effective DCP cropland.

Important: The query provides all FAV and WR acreage reported or determined as planted on the farm. In some situations, not all planted FAV and WR acreage should be counted for compliance purposes.

This query is based on the total FAV and WR acreage planted on the farm as reported by the producer or determined by the County Office. If acreage has been determined on the farm, determined acreage will be displayed under the "Rptd or Detd Planted Acreage" column and a "1" will be displayed in the "Determined Acres Used" column. If acreage has not been determined on the farm, reported acreage will be displayed under the "Rptd or Detd Planted Acreage" column and a "0" will be displayed in the "Determined Acres Used" column.

See subparagraph 3 D for farms that have some FAV's with determined acres and some FAV's with only reported acres.

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2 2004 FAV/WR Query Descriptions (Continued)

B Query FAVRP4A1 (Continued)

The following table provides a description of each field provided by query FAVRP4A1.

Name	Description
Farm Number	Farm number.
Eff DCP Cropland	Farm's effective DCP cropland as provided in the farm file A.MI.TRM.
Base Acreage	Farm's base acreage as provided in the farm file A.MI.FTM.
Free Acres Available for FAV's	The number of nonbase acres (free acres) that may be planted to FAV's or WR without a DCP contract violation or payment reduction. The amount of nonbase acres is determined by subtracting total base acres from effective DCP cropland.
Excess FAV	The total FAV and WR acres planted on base acres. Note: The "Excess FAV" acreage listed may include double-cropped, subsequent, experimental, and multiple plantings of FAV's and WR. Therefore, this acreage may not be the final acreage to be entered into the FAV Payment Reduction Software for acre-for-acre reductions.
Crop Code	OFAV crop code of "773" or WR crop code of "641".
Irr Prct	"I" for irrigated or "N" for nonirrigated.
Rptd or Detd Planted Acreage	The total FAV and WR acreage reported or determined planted on the farm as provided in the FSA-578 summary file A.ME.S4M.
Determined Acres Used	"0" indicates that reported acreage is displayed in the "Rptd or Detd Planted Acreage" column. "1" indicates determined acreage is displayed in the "Rptd or Detd Planted Acreage" column.

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2 2004 FAV/WR Query Descriptions (Continued)

C Query FAVRP4B1

Query FAVRP4B1, 2004 FAV's on Base Acres - Nonbase Acres Less Than Zero, will provide a list of farms that meet both of the following:

- the amount of non-base acres for the farm is less than zero
- reported or determined FAV or WR planted acreage on the farm.

FAV and WR records will be listed separately. Irrigated and nonirrigated records will be listed separately.

Notes: The amount of nonbase acres for a farm is calculated by subtracting the total DCP base acres for the farm from the farm's total effective DCP cropland.

The only farms that will be displayed on this query are farms that have base acres that exceed effective DCP cropland because of double cropped history.

Important: The query provides all FAV and WR acreage reported or determined as planted on the farm. In some situations, not all planted FAV and WR acreage should be counted for compliance purposes.

This query is based on the total FAV and WR acreage planted on the farm as reported by the producer or determined by the County Office. If acreage has been determined on the farm, determined acreage will be displayed under the "Rptd or Detd Planted Acreage" column and a "1" will be displayed in the "Determined Acres Used" column. If acreage has not been determined on the farm, reported acreage will be displayed under the "Rptd or Detd Planted Acreage" column and a "0" will be displayed in the "Determined Acres Used" column.

See subparagraph 3 D for farms that have some FAV's with determined acres and some FAV's with only reported acres.

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2 2004 FAV/WR Query Descriptions (Continued)

C Query FAVRP4B1 (Continued)

The following table provides a description of each field provided by query FAVRP4B1.

Name	Description
Farm Number	Farm number.
Eff DCP Cropland	Farm's effective DCP cropland as provided in the farm tract file A.MI.TRM.
Base Acreage	Farm's base acreage as provided in the farm file A.MI.FTM.
Free Acres Available for FAV's	The number of nonbase acres (free acres) that may be planted to FAV's or WR without a DCP contract violation. The amount of nonbase acres is determined by subtracting total base acres from effective DCP cropland. Note: Free acres will always be zero on this query.
Excess FAV	The total FAV and WR acres planted on base acres. Note: The "Excess FAV" acreage listed may include double-cropped FAV's, subsequent, experimental and multiple plantings of FAV's and WR. Therefore, this acreage may not be the final acreage to be entered into the Payment Reduction Software for acre-for-acre reductions.
Crop Code	OFAV crop code of "773" or WR crop code of "641".
Irr Prct	"I" for irrigated or "N" for nonirrigated.
Rptd or Detd Planted Acreage	The total FAV and WR acreage reported or determined planted on the farm as provided in the 578 summary file A.ME.S4M.
Determined Acres Used	"0" indicates that reported acreage is displayed in the "Rptd or Detd Planted Acreage" column. "1" indicates determined acreage is displayed in the "Rptd or Detd Planted Acreage" column.

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2 2004 FAV/WR Query Descriptions (Continued)

D Query FAVSMR41

Query FAVSMR41, 2004 FAV Summary of Reported or Determined Acreage, will provide FAV and WR acreage reported by the producer or determined by the County Office as summarized in the FSA-578 Summary File, A.ME.S4M. This query will provide the total FAV and WR acreage on the farm that is reported or determined as planted, double cropped, failed, prevented, or experimental. Listed below is a description of each field provided by query FAVSMR41.

Note: FAV and WR records will be listed separately. Irrigated and nonirrigated records will be listed separately. If FAV/WR acreage has been determined on the farm, both reported and determined acreage will be listed separately.

Name	Description
Farm Number	Farm number.
Crop Code	OFAV crop code of "773" or WR crop code of "641".
IRR Prac Code	"I" for irrigated or "N" for nonirrigated.
Planted Acreage- Rpt	The number of FAV and WR acres on the farm that were reported by the producer as planted.
Planted Acreage- Det	The number of FAV and WR acres on the farm that were determined by the County Office as planted.
Dbl Pgm Crop Acre-Rpt	The FAV and WR acreage on the farm reported by the producer as being double-cropped.
Dbl Pgm Crop Acre-Det	The determined FAV and WR acreage on the farm that was double-cropped.
Failed Acreage - Rpt	The FAV and WR acreage on the farm reported by the producer as failed.
Failed Acreage - Det	The determined FAV and WR acreage on the farm reported as failed.
Prevented Plnt Acr - Rpt	The FAV and WR acreage on the farm that the producer reported as prevented planted.
Prevented Plnt Acr - Det	The determined FAV and WR acreage on the farm reported as prevented planted.

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2 2004 FAV/WR Query Descriptions (Continued)

D Query FAVSMR41 (Continued)

Name	Description
Experimental Acreage – Reported	The FAV and WR acreage on the farm reported by the producer as experimental.
Experimental Acreage – Determined	The determined FAV and WR acreage on the farm reported as experimental.
“Y” Means Determined Acres Used	“Y” indicates determined FAV/WR acreage exist on the farm.

See subparagraph 3 D for farms that have some FAV’s with determined acres and some FAV’s with only reported acres.

3 2004 FAV and WR Query Exceptions

A Double Cropping Region Exception

FAV’s and WR may be planted on base acres enrolled in DCP without violation or acre-for-acre payment reduction if FAV or WR, as applicable, is planted in a double-cropping cycle with a covered commodity or peanuts planted in a designated FAV double-cropping region established by STC. See 1-DCP, paragraph 473.

The FAV/WR queries do not recognize FAV/WR double-cropping regions. Therefore, if the farm is administratively located in an approved FAV/WR double-cropping region, the County Office must manually determine if:

- FAV or WR is double-cropped with a covered commodity or peanuts on the same acreage in a 12-month period
- all requirements in 1-DCP, paragraph 473 are met.

If all these criteria are met, the County Office must subtract the FAV and WR acreage that is double-cropped with a covered commodity or peanuts from the “Rptd or Detd Planted Acreage” and “Excess FAV” columns on queries FAVRP4A1 and FAVRP4B1, as applicable.

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3 2004 FAV and WR Query Exceptions (Continued)

B Multiple FAV's on Same Acreage in Same FY

As provided in 1-DCP, paragraph 471, multiple plantings of any FAV on the same acreage in an FY shall be considered only once for DCP compliance purposes. Therefore, if a farm has multiple plantings of any FAV or WR on the same acreage in a fiscal year, the County Office must subtract the applicable acreage from the "Rptd or Detd Planted Acreage" and "Excess FAV" columns on queries FAVRP4A1 or FAVRP4B1, as applicable.

C Experimental FAV/WR Acreage

Acres planted to FAV/WR for experimental purposes shall **not** be considered for DCP compliance purposes if **all** the following are met:

- the experiment is conducted under the direct supervision of a State experiment station or commercial company
- the production is either of the following:
 - destroyed before harvest
 - used for testing or other experimental purposes
- a representative of the State experiment station or the commercial company certifies that any production harvested from the experiment will not be:
 - marketed in any form
 - used for any benefit, including donation
- the farm operator certifies that no harvested production of the crop has or will be received
- by the final reporting date, the farm operator:
 - reported the acreage to be excluded
 - identified the acreage on a photocopy
 - paid for a farm visit to verify how the crop was used.

FAV/WR coded with an "E" for experimental are included in the "Rptd or Detd Planted Acreage" and "Excess FAV" columns on queries FAVRP4A1 or FAVRP4B1. Therefore, if a crop is coded with an "E" and meets this definition, the County Office must subtract the acreage from the "Rptd or Detd Planted Acreage" and "Excess FAV" columns on queries FAVRP4A1 or FAVRP4B1, as applicable.

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3 2004 FAV and WR Query Exceptions (Continued)

D Farms With Partial Determined FAV/WR Acreage

If a farm has some FAV's with determined acres and some FAV's with only reported acres, queries FAVRP4A1 and FAVRP4B1 will not pick up the crops having only reported acres. Therefore, the planted FAV acreage must be manually calculated. For example, tomatoes and okra are reported as planted on the farm, but only the tomato acreage is determined. The queries will not pick up the okra reported acreage.

To identify farms that have some FAV's with determined acres and some FAV's with only reported acres, the County Office shall print the Missing Determined Discrepancy Report, according to 2-CP, paragraph 376. The Missing Determined Discrepancy Report will provide a list of farms that have some FAV's with determined acres and some FAV's with only reported acres. Exhibit 1 provides an example of the Missing Determined Discrepancy Report.

Important: For all farms listed on the Missing Determined Discrepancy Report, the FAV/WR queries shall not be used to determine the number of DCP base acres planted to FAV's or WR.

If a farm has some FAV's with determined acres and some FAV's with only reported acres, the County Office shall follow procedure in the following table to manually determine FAV/WR acreage planted on base acres.

Step	Action
1	Determine FAV and WR acreage planted on the farm as provided on the FSA-578 Farm and Tract Detail Listing.
2	Determine the number of FAV and WR acreage planted on base acres enrolled in DCP, according to 4-CP, subparagraph 21 B.

Note: If the County Office has not completed spot checking FAV's and WR, the County Office may have to re-run the FAV and WR queries when spotchecks have been completed and determined acreage has been entered in the acreage reporting software.

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3 2004 FAV and WR Query Exceptions (Continued)

E Horseradish

Horseradish is an FAV. However, the FSA-578 summary process does not summarize horseradish as an FAV. The County Office must:

- manually determine which farms have acreage planted to horseradish
- use the following table to determine whether FAV/WR are planted on base acres.

IF the farm with acreage planted to horseradish is...	THEN the County Office shall...
listed on either query FAVRP4A1 or FAVRP4B1	add horseradish acreage to the "Rptd or Detd Planted Acreage" and "Excess FAV" columns on the applicable query. Note: County Offices must follow procedure in paragraph 7 to determine the correct horseradish acreage to be added to the applicable query.
not listed on either query FAVRP4A1 or FAVRP4B1	follow procedure in the table in subparagraph 3 D to determine FAV and WR planted on base acres.

4 Accessing 2004 Queries

A Procedure

The 2004 FAV and WR queries shall be accessed using the instructions in this table.

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5 Using Queries FAVRP4A1 and FAVRP4B1

A Purpose

The queries described in this notice are to be used by the County Office only as a tool in determining FAV and WR acreage planted on base acres and acre-for-acre reduction amounts.

B Reported or Determined FAV Acreage

Queries FAVRP4A1 and FAVRP4B1 use **reported or determined** FAV and WR acreage. If the County Office has determined all FAV and WR acreage for the farm, the determined acreage shall be used in calculating the number of FAV and WR acres planted on base acres. Therefore, if FAV and WR acreage has been determined on the farm, determined acreage will be displayed under the "Rptd or Detd Planted Acreage" column and a "1" will be displayed in the "Determined Acres Used" column. If no FAV and WR acreage has been determined for the entire farm, reported acreage will be displayed under the "Rptd or Detd Planted Acreage" column and a "0" will be displayed in the "Determined Acres Used" column.

Important: If a farm has some FAV's with determined acres and some FAV's with only reported acres, the query is not picking up the crops having only reported acres. Therefore, FAV's must be manually calculated. See subparagraph 3 E.

C Nonbase Acreage

Queries FAVRP4A1 and FAVRP4B1 shall both be used by the County Office. The difference in the 2 queries is that:

- query FAVRP4A1 only lists farms that have base acres equal to or less than effective DCP cropland
- query FAVRP4B1 only lists farms that have base acres greater than effective DCP cropland.

Note: The only time base acres are greater than effective DCP cropland is when a farm has double-cropped history.

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5 Using Queries FAVRP4A1 and FAVRP4B1 (Continued)

D FAV's Planted on DCP Base Acres

On queries FAVRP4A1 and FAVRP4B1 the column titled "Rptd or Detd Planted Acreage" includes the following FAV and WR reported or determined acreage, as applicable:

- initial
- subsequent
- double-cropped
- repeat
- failed
- experimental.

Therefore, the result in the "Excess FAV" column may **not** be the final FAV and WR acreage planted on base acres enrolled in DCP to be entered in the compliance software for acre-for-acre reductions. The County Office must use all three queries as described in this notice to determine the final FAV and WR acreage to be entered in the compliance software for acre-for-acre reductions.

6 Using Query FAVSMR41

A Purpose

Query FAVSMR41 indicates how certain FAV and WR acreage was recorded in the FSA-578 software. The County Office shall use query FAVSMR41 to determine which acreage should be added or subtracted from the "Rptd or Detd Planted Acreage" and "Excess FAV" columns on queries FAVRP4A1 and FAVRP4B1, as applicable.

Note: Query FAVSMR41 lists both reported and determined FAV acreage on the farm.

Important: If a farm has some FAV's with determined acres and some FAV's with only reported acres, the query is not picking up the crops having only reported acres. Therefore, FAV's must be manually calculated. See subparagraph 3 E.

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7 Required Action

A County Office Action

The following table provides FAV and WR scenarios and the applicable County Office action that must be taken to accurately determine DCP acre-for-acre reductions for farms with all reported or all determined FAV and WR acreage.

Important: County Offices shall follow procedure in subparagraph 3:

- D if a farm has some FAV’s with determined acres and some FAV’s with only reported acres.
- E if a farm has horseradish reported or determined planted on the farm.

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7 Required Action (Continued)

A County Office Action (Continued)

The “Rpt or Det Planted Acreage” column of the FAV and WR queries include FAV’s and WR reported or determined, as applicable, with either of the following crop status codes:

- “R” for repeat crops
- “S” for subsequent crops.

FAV’s and WR that meet the requirements to have a crop status code of “R”, as provided in 2-CP, Exhibit 11, shall **not** be considered for FAV and WR compliance purposes according to 1-DCP, paragraph 471.

FAV’s and WR acreage that meet the requirements to have a crop status code of “S”, as provided in 2-CP, paragraph 73, **may** not be considered for FAV and WR compliance purposes according to 1-DCP, paragraph 471.

Subtract the applicable acreage from the “Rpt or Detd Planted Acreage” and “Excess FAV” columns on query FAVRP4A1 or FAVRP4B1, if FAV’s or WR is recorded in the FSA-578 software with either a crop status code of:

- “R” that meets the requirements of a repeat crop
- “S” that meets the requirements of a subsequent crop and the initial crop is another FAV or WR.

Note: No action is required for the FAV/WR coded as “S” if the initial crop is any crop other than FAV or WR.

8 Example

A Example of How to Use FAV and WR Queries

Exhibit 2 provides examples of the 3 queries. The following table provides an explanation for 1 farm on the queries and how to use the queries to accurately determine DCP acre-for-acre reduction on the farm. Exhibit 3 provides the FSA-578 for the farm provided in the table below.
