Announcing Emergency Livestock Relief Program (ELRP) 2023 and 2024 Final Payment

1 Overview

A Background

The American Relief Act, 2025 (Pub. L. 118-158) and 7 CFR Part 760, Subpart T published on May 29, 2025, authorized ELRP 2023 and 2024. Notice ELRP-6 announced the implementation of ELRP 2023 and 2024 providing assistance to eligible livestock producers to offset foregone profits resulting from the loss of quality and quantity of forage because of qualifying drought and wildfires in 2023 and 2024.

The initial ELRP 2023 and 2024 payments for compensating livestock producers for a portion of their foregone profits in 2023 and 2024 were factored by 35 percent because of limited funding. As announced in the [Emergency Livestock Relief Program \(ELRP\) 2023 and 2024 FR notice](#) published May 29, 2025, an additional ELRP 2023 and 2024 payment may be issued if funding is available after losses for ELRP 2023 and 2024 Flood and Wildfire are determined, not to exceed 60 percent compensation of calculated foregone profits.

DAFP has determined that there is available funding to issue a final payment for 2023 and 2024 losses. The ELRP 2023 and 2024 program deadline was November 21, 2025. No action is required for eligible producers to receive the additional ELRP 2023 and 2024 payment; however, producers must file all payment eligibility forms, as applicable, by **November 2, 2026**, according to 1-ELRP, subparagraph 31 B, to be eligible for payment, if they have not done so already.

B Purpose

This notice announces that FSA will issue final ELRP 2023 and 2024 payments.

2 Issuing Final ELRP 2023 and 2024 Payments

A Final ELRP 2023 and 2024 Payment Factor Determination

Eligible livestock producers were not required to submit an application for ELRP 2023 and 2024. As specified in Notice ELRP-6 and 1-ELRP, paragraph 31, FSA is using data already submitted to FSA through the Livestock Forage Disaster Program (LFP) as proxy. ELRP 2023 and 2024 provided that the initial payment was equal to the eligible livestock producer's 2023 or 2024 LFP gross calculated payment multiplied by a 35 percent payment factor to stay within available funding. An additional payment may be issued if funding is available after losses for flooding and wildfire are determined, not to exceed 60 percent of calculated foregone profits.

DAFP has evaluated ELRP program demand for drought, wildfire, and flooding losses and determined to issue a final ELRP 2023 and 2024 payment of an additional 8.2 percent with available funding, for a total payment factor of 43.2 percent. The following table illustrates the maximum percentage of calculated foregone profits per year per animal unit (AU) that will be covered by ELRP 2023 and 2024.

The ELRP 2023 and 2024 maximum payment per AU (row D) and the corresponding percentage of foregone profits (row F) will be lower if the LFP gross payment, used as a proxy, is based on less than a maximum 5-month payment for drought or 180 days for wildfire.

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2 Issuing Final ELRP 2023 and 2024 Payments (Continued)

B ELRP 2023 and 2024 Program and Payment Eligibility Deadline

For ELRP 2023 and 2024 program eligibility, a livestock producer must have an approved LFP application on file with FSA for the applicable program year by the program deadline of November 21, 2025, according to 1-ELRP, subparagraph 35 G. As specified in 1-ELRP, subparagraph 31 B, producers must have the following additional forms on file with FSA by **November 2, 2026**, to be eligible to receive payment:

- CCC-902, according to 6-PL
- CCC-901, if applicable, according to 6-PL
- AD-1026, according to 6-CP
- SF-3881 (direct deposit) for each applicant
- FSA-510, for each applicant and entity member, if applicable for an increased payment limitation.

Note: FSA-510 version 05/29/2025 has been updated to include authority of the American Relief Act and should be used for ELRP 2023 and 2024.

These forms must be completed according to 1-ELRP and updated into the web-based Subsidiary System files upon receipt and according to 3-PL (Rev. 2).

C Issuing ELRP 2023 and 2024

ELRP 2023 and 2024 payments:

- are processed nightly
- will continue to be reprocessed if changes are made to eligibility or to the corresponding LFP application.

If there is an issue with an ELRP 2023 or 2024 application or payment, or assistance is needed with a payment in suspended status, the State Office specialist should update the application information on the Program Delivery Division SharePoint site for ELRP 2023 and 2024 at https://usdagcc.sharepoint.com/sites/fsa-dafp-disaster/Payment_Issues/Lists/ELRP/Main.aspx

Note: The PDD Software Issues SharePoint site is only for State Office specialists and the National Office. County Offices must not request access.
