1 Training Requirements and Access

A Background

Certain Federal regulations and Executive Orders require **all** Federal agencies to consult with Indian Tribes in a Government-to-Government relationship. To help Federal agencies accomplish this requirement, the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation in partnership with various Indian Tribes and Federal agencies has developed an online, 1-hour training.

B Purpose

This notice informs State Environmental Coordinators (SEC's) that this 1-hour online training is mandatory, free, and **must** be completed by **April 25, 2008**. All County Office employees are encouraged to take this course and it is highly recommended for employees who work with Indian Tribes.

C Training Information

To access the training, go to **www.golearn.gov**. On the Home Page, scroll down and **CLICK "Click here to Register for "Working Effectively with Tribal Governments" Course"**. Users will be prompted to register for the course.

Note: The training allows users to save their progress and come back at a later time.
