1 Overview

A Background

Notice FI-3051 announced a modification to eFMS that allows a program to have an allotment at the National Office level, rather than at the individual County Office level. When a program is allotted at the National Office level, it is **not** necessary for the National program manager or the State program manager to move funds to an individual county. The program will **not** be visible in eFMS to the State program manager.
