1 Overview

A Background

To reduce costs and risks to the Agency, the Code of Federal Regulations was recently revised to allow for the elimination of cash as an acceptable form of payment.

Recent Farm Production and Conservation (FPAC) automation innovations have made it possible to accept payments through debit cards or Automated Clearing House (ACH) debits for most farm and loan programs. Debit cards and ACH debits are **not** currently acceptable forms of payment for MAL, FSFL, and NAP fees.

B Purpose

This notice provides notification that FSA will limit cash payments to no more than \$100.00 per transaction. Payments over \$100.00 can be made in the form of ACH debit, check, debit card, money order, or wire transfer.

2 Definitions

A Debit Card

<u>Debit card</u> is defined as a payment card that deducts money directly from a customer's bank account to pay for a purchase.

B ACH Debit

<u>ACH debit</u> is defined as a transaction that withdraws funds from a checking or savings account.
