

Assignment of Native American Loans to a Tribe or the Secretary of Interior

Approved by: Acting Deputy Administrator, Farm Loan Programs



1 Overview

A Purpose

This notice:

- provides instructions for processing assignment of a Native American borrower's loans to a Tribe or Secretary of Interior when requested according to Notice FLP-467
- includes exhibits to notify the following:
 - Tribe of a request by a Native American borrower that the Tribe be assigned a loan (Exhibit 1)
 - Native American borrower of a decision by the Tribe or Secretary of Interior to accept a borrower's loan assignment request (Exhibit 2)
 - Native American borrower of a decision by the Tribe or Secretary of Interior to deny the borrower's loan assignment request (Exhibit 3).

2 Action

A Farm Loan Manager (FLM) Responsibilities

Upon receipt of a request from a Native American borrower made according to Notice FLP-467, FLM's shall do the following.

Step	Action
1	<p>If the borrower requests that the Tribe be assigned the loan, FLM shall notify the Tribe of the borrower's request and advise the Tribe to respond to FSA about their intention to accept or deny such a request within 30 calendar days. See Exhibit 1.</p> <p>The notification to the Tribe shall include the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• copy of the current appraisal of the real estate and valuations of all chattel security• copy of the borrower's promissory notes to be assigned• copy of all security instruments• amount the Tribe would be required to pay FSA for assignment of the loan <p>Note: This amount shall equal the lesser of the present market value of all loan security or the principal and interest outstanding on the loan.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• statement that the Tribe may pay for the assignment transaction over a period of time under terms and conditions similar to the Indian Tribal Land Acquisition Program (ITLAP).
2	<p>If the borrower requests that the Secretary of Interior be assigned the loan, FLM shall refer the request, along with a copy of each of the following, through SED, to the National Office:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• current appraisal of remaining FSA security• borrower's promissory notes• all security instruments. <p>Note: The National Office address is as follows.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">FSA DAFLP LSPMD STOP 0523 1400 INDEPENDENCE AVE SW WASHINGTON DC 20250-0523</p> <p>The National Office will work with the BIA National Office to determine whether the Secretary of Interior will accept the assignment of the loan.</p>

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2 Action (Continued)

A Farm Loan Manager (FLM) Responsibilities (Continued)

Step	Action
3	FLM shall notify the borrower that the request has been forwarded. Once the Secretary of Interior determination is made, the National Office, through SED, will notify FLM of the decision and how to proceed.
4	Upon Agency receipt of the decision by the Tribe or the Secretary of Interior to accept the borrower's loan assignment request, FLM shall notify the borrower of the decision according to Exhibit 2.
5	<p>If the Tribe has indicated that it will accept an assignment of the loan and will seek to pay for the transaction over a period of time, FLM shall send the Tribe, the following for the Tribe to execute within 90 calendar days:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a promissory note payable to FSA in exchange for the assignment of the loan • any other loan documents required by FSA to finance this debt under rates and terms similar to an ITLAP loan, including an assignment of Tribal income as security for the Tribe's loan. <p>The promissory note shall be prepared with the consideration amount as determined under step 1 and with rates and terms similar to an ITLAP loan.</p> <p>Note: All ITLAP servicing options may be applied to these loans, except for write down servicing options that are not available for these loans.</p>
6	If the Tribe has timely executed and returned the documents described in step 5, FLM shall send to the Tribe all original borrower promissory notes and mortgages being assigned, along with any other relevant security instruments. Agency documents provided to the Tribe shall be prepared, endorsed, processed, and delivered according to guidance from the regional OGC.
7	<p>If the decision of the Tribe or the Secretary of Interior is not to accept the assignment of the loan, FLM shall:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • notify the borrower according to Exhibit 3 • proceed with foreclosure action according to applicable procedures. <p>Note: Failure of the Tribe to respond to a request that the Tribe accepts an assignment of the loan, or to finalize the loan assignment transaction within the time provided in this notice, shall be treated as a denial of the request.</p>
8	FLM shall keep copies of all letters or documents sent or received in the borrower's loan file.

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2 Action (Continued)

B FLM or Finance Office Responsibilities

FLM or Finance Office shall do the following.

Step	Action
1	<p>The Financial Services Center (FSC), Farm Loan Operations Office (FLOO) shall process all transactions related to the assignment of a Native American account to a Tribe or the Secretary of Interior upon receipt of a transmittal letter from the servicing office accompanied by copies of the assignment agreement and promissory notes that are assigned.</p> <p>The servicing office transmittal letter must provide to FSC, FLOO the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• present market value of the security assigned• number of acres under FSA security instruments• amount of the annual installments to be paid by the Tribe under any ITLAP rate and term financing provided. <p>If the Tribe pays the full assignment consideration price in cash, as opposed to ITLAP rate and term financing, the servicing office transmittal letter will notify FSC, FLOO accordingly and include the information from the payment transmittal record.</p> <p>If the Secretary of Interior has accepted the assignment, the borrower’s loan will be assigned to the Secretary of Interior according to National Office instructions. See subparagraph A, step 3.</p> <p>FSC, FLOO will close out the Native American borrower’s FSA loan account and no further servicing action will be required.</p> <p>If the Tribe has accepted the assignment of the borrower’s loan and has given FSA a new promissory note for the purchase of the loan, payments received by FSA on a new Tribal loan to pay the “assignment” should follow the same guidelines currently used for regular ITLAP payment processing.</p>

Dear Sir or Madam:

This letter concerns the request of (borrower's name) that the enclosed Farm Service Agency (FSA) loans and security instruments be assigned to the Tribe pursuant to section 335(e)(1)(A)(v) of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act (7 U.S.C. 1985(e)(1)(A)(v)).

If the Tribe agrees to accept the assignment of these loans, the Tribe will pay FSA (\$) in exchange for the assigned loans. The amount to be paid for the assignment of the loans represents the lesser of the outstanding principal and interest of the loans or the present market value of the security for the loans. The Tribe may pay for the purchase of the assignment over time under terms and conditions similar to those applicable to the Indian Tribal Land Acquisition Program, or the Tribe may purchase the assignment without FSA financing.

We request that you inform this office of your decision regarding your intention to accept the assignment of the loans by returning to this office a copy of this letter with the appropriate box marked within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter. If we do not receive a response within this 30-day time period, we will proceed as if you have denied the borrower's request. Your decision must be to either accept assignment of all or none of the loans the borrower has requested be assigned to the Tribe. We will treat any response that does not accept the assignment of all loans as a denial of the borrower's request.

Notification to a Native American Borrower of Denial of an Assignment Request

In response to your request, we submitted a request to the (Tribe or the Secretary of Interior) to accept the assignment of your Farm Service Agency (FSA) Farm Loan Programs loans identified as (loan numbers). Unfortunately, your request was denied.

Therefore, you may wish to pursue option C, D, or E contained in our letter of (date of letter sent to borrower pursuant to Notice FLP-467). If you do not successfully pursue one of these options, FSA will proceed toward foreclosure action. Although FSA's foreclosure process will not be delayed while you attempt other options or resolution actions, FSA will stop the foreclosure process and sale if you otherwise successfully resolve your indebtedness with FSA before any scheduled foreclosure sale.
