1 Cooperative Agreement

A Background

On April 6, 2010, FSA published a Notice of Funds Availability requesting applications for the American Indian Credit Outreach Initiative. The Native American Community Development Corporation (NACDC) was selected as Cooperator, replacing the National Tribal Development Association (NTDA).

FSA and NACDC entered into a cooperative agreement to assist American Indian applicants and borrowers with the technical assistance needed to better understand FSA loanmaking and servicing programs.

FSA employees shall no longer refer applicants and borrowers to NTDA. FLP staff must continue to provide technical assistance to American Indian applicants and borrowers, and ensure that applications begun with NTDA are continued. Offices shall contact the local NTDA representative to determine whether there are any pending applications that require FLP assistance.
