

1 Distributing Youth Loan Livestock Pen Signs

A Background

DAFLP has purchased 2,500 Youth Loan livestock pen signs to be used to promote the Youth Loan Program by recognizing youth loan borrowers on their farm and when they participate in livestock shows and events.

B Purpose

This notice informs State and County Offices about requesting and using youth loan pen signs.

C Requesting Signs

C Requesting Signs (Continued)

Notes: Signs will be distributed to FLC in increments of 25. Additional signs may be requested as needed.

The signs are 12 x 24 inch plates with holes to allow hanging or attaching to livestock pens. Following is an example.



D Distributing Signs to Youth Loan Borrowers

Loan Closing Official shall:

- provide a sign to youth loan borrowers at closing and encourage them to display the sign in a prominent place on their farm
- request that the borrower attach the sign to stalls or pens when participating in county fairs, livestock shows, FFA or 4-H events, etc.
