1 Overview

A Background

The FSFL program receives an apportionment each FY to fund FSFL's approved that FY. The initial FY 2010 FSFL apportionment was entirely obligated as of April 26, 2010.

In Notice FSFL-71, State and County Offices were notified:

- of the provisions of the Antideficiency Act and implications on the FSFL program
- that the FY 2010 FSFL apportionment was entirely obligated as of April 26, 2010
- that FY 2010 FSFL's were **not** to be approved until additional funding is available
- of procedure for approving FSFL's when additional FY 2010 funding is received.

B Purpose

This notice informs State and County Offices that:

- an additional FSFL apportionment for FY 2010 has been approved
- FY 2010 FSFL's can now be approved according to paragraph 2.

2 Action

A COC and County Office Action

For all FSFL's on which they are the approval authority, COC's shall:

- commence reviewing and approving all pending FY 2010 FSFL CCC-185's on which site preparation and bin construction have **not** started according to 1-FSFL
- forward to STC:
 - for approval all FSFL's which require STC approval
 - for approval or referral to DAFP, all CCC-185's on which construction of the facility started **before** approval
- resume approving increases to FY 2010 obligations, as applicable
- notify applicants of loan approval and approval interest rate **only** when the obligation has been returned to the County Office
- not enter an approval date into the FSFL software during the time period when funding was unavailable.

Note: FY 2010 FSFL's **cannot** have an approval date of April 27, 2010, through April 29, 2010.

Important: This would be a violation of the Antideficiency Act according to Notice FSFL-71.

B State Office Action

State Offices shall:

- ensure that all County Offices and COC's are aware that:
 - additional FY 2010 FSFL funding is now available
 - FY 2010 FSFL's may now be approved according to this notice
- obtain STC approval for all loans on which they are the approval authority.
