### 3 GRP Obligation Deadlines

#### A State Office Action

State Offices must make sure County Offices follow Notice CM-672 requiring all 2010 GRP contracts and easement application be recorded in the System 36 by 8 p.m. c.t. September 17, 2010.

State Offices with funds that will **not** be obligated or that require additional GRP funds, should provide the following to Jim Williams by e-mail at [jim.williams@wdc.usda.gov](mailto:jim.williams@wdc.usda.gov) as soon as possible but no later than COB September 1, 2010:

- amount of funds not required and available for release
- list of applications and the funds needed to fund them.

#### B County Office Action

County Office shall follow the guidance in Notice CM-672.
