Change in Livestock Types for Chickens for 2011 LIP

1 Overview

A Background

LIP provides separate payment rates for eligible livestock owners and eligible contract growers. Payment rates for:

- livestock owners are based on 75 percent of a fair market value, as determined by FSA, for the specific livestock category
- contract growers are based on 75 percent of the average income loss sustained, as determined by FSA, by the contract grower with respect to the dead livestock.

For 2008, 2009, and 2010, per head payment rates for chickens were established for:

- livestock owners, based on the livestock types of layers/roasters, broilers/pullets, and chicks
- contract growers, based on the livestock types of layers/roasters and broilers/pullets.

To better reflect the chicken types being grown for 2011, per head payment rates for chickens for:

- livestock owners, have been established based on the livestock types of layers, roasters, broilers/pullets (regular size), pullets/Cornish hens (small size), and chicks
- contract growers, have been established based on the livestock types of layers, roasters, broilers/pullets (regular size), and pullets/Cornish hens (small size).

B Purpose

This notice informs State and County Offices that for 2011:

- per head payment rates for chickens have been established for:
 - livestock owners, based on the livestock types of layers, roasters, broilers/pullets (regular size), pullets/Cornish hens (small size), and chicks
 - contract growers, based on the livestock types of layers, roasters, broilers/pullets (regular size), and pullets/Cornish hens (small size)
- STC's shall establish normal mortality rates for the specific types of chicken for livestock owners and contract growers on a State-by-State basis according to 1-LDAP, subparagraph 41 I
- the process for loading mortality rates into the automated system is according to 1-LDAP, Part 3, Section 2.

2 2011 Normal Mortality Rates for Chickens

A Establishing 2011 Normal Mortality Rates for Chickens

STC's shall immediately establish normal mortality rates according to 1-LDAP, subparagraph 41 I for the following chicken types for:

- livestock owners:
 - layers
 - roasters
 - broilers/pullets (regular size)
 - pullets/Cornish hens (small size)
 - chicks
- contract growers:
 - layers
 - roasters
 - broilers/pullets (regular size)
 - pullets/Cornish hens (small size).

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2 2011 Normal Mortality Rates for Chickens (Continued)

B Loading 2011 Normal Mortality Rates for Chickens

After new normal mortality rates have been established for chickens according to subparagraph A, State Offices shall immediately:

- delete the 2011 mortality rates for the chicken types of layers/roasters and broilers/pullets in the automated software according to 1-LDAP, paragraph 137
- add the new 2011 mortality rates for the chicken types established for livestock owners and contract growers according to subparagraph A in the automated software according to 1-LDAP, paragraph 138
