**1 Overview**

**A Background**

Web Transmittal No. 650 provided that the following software modifications to LIP signup have been made:

- removed the validation that prompts the message to delete Notice of Loss (NOL) when payment data is tied to a disapproved NOL
- removed the validation that an application cannot be approved that is tied to a disapproved NOL
- added a validation that an application tied to a disapproved NOL may only be approved if the claimed livestock death losses are adjusted to zero.

**B Purpose**

This notice provides that when livestock death losses are entered in the application software and the corresponding NOL is disapproved:

- a new error message will be displayed on Part D of the Livestock Information Screen and Producer Summary Screen
- County Offices must adjust claimed death losses to zero, as provided in subparagraph 2 C
- COC will not be able to approve the application until claimed death losses are adjusted to zero, as provided in subparagraph 2 C.

## 2 Software Modifications

### A Part D of the Livestock Information Screen - Removed Validation and Error Message

When livestock death losses tied to a disapproved NOL are entered on Part D of the Livestock Information Screen, the following error message will no longer be displayed.

**Important:** Disapproved NOL's no longer need to be deleted for COC's to approve an application. Instead, County Offices must follow procedure in subparagraphs B and C to adjust the eligible livestock losses and/or normal mortality losses to zero.

### 2 Software Modifications (Continued)

#### C Required Adjustments to Livestock Losses

If livestock death losses (losses because of a claimed eligible loss condition and losses because of normal mortality) are entered in the application software and COC has disapproved the corresponding NOL (no eligible loss condition exists), the claimed death losses must be reduced to zero. In this situation, the County Office must adjust the claimed death losses to zero on the following Edit Subsequent Loss for Livestock Screen, in either or both of the following fields, as applicable:

- “Number of livestock that died due to current eligible loss condition”
- “Number of livestock that died due to normal mortality after xx/xx/xxxx and on or before xx/xx/xxxx”.

CLICK “Save Loss” at the bottom of the screen.

#### E Producer Summary Screen – New Error Message and Validation


When livestock death losses tied to a disapproved NOL are entered in the application software and the County Office does not adjust the claimed livestock losses to zero, as provided in subparagraph C, COC will not be able to approve the application for payment. The following error message will be displayed on the Producer Summary Screen.

**!** An application with a disapproved NOL tied to a Livestock Loss can only be approved if the value entered in the Livestock Loss for "Number of livestock that died due to current eligible loss condition" or "Number of livestock that died due to normal mortality" has been COC adjusted to zero.
