1 2013 Crop Peanut Warehouse Rates

A Background

The Food, Conservation, and Energy Act of 2008 (2008 Act), Section 1307(a)(6)(A) authorizes the Secretary to use CCC funds to pay handling, and other associated costs (other than storage costs), to ensure proper storage of 2008 through 2012 crop year peanuts pledged as security for CCC MAL's. This handling amount will be added to the loan disbursement at loanmaking. The handling charges will include the State-specific grading and inspection fees for peanuts. The American Taxpayer Relief Act of 2012 (ATRA) extends MAL provisions to the 2013 crop year.

Accordingly, 2008 Act, Section 1307 (a)(6)(B)(i) requires the repayment of handling and associated cost when MAL is redeemed. For peanuts forfeited to CCC, the Secretary is authorized in Section 1307(a)(6)(B)(ii) to pay storage, handling, and other associated costs for all peanuts pledged as collateral that are forfeited for the 2008 through 2012 crop years. ATRA extends these provisions to the 2013 crop year.

CCC will pay load-in charges and load-out charges, when applicable, if CCC deems it necessary to load-out CCC-owned peanuts.

B Purpose

This notice informs State and County Offices of the:

- approved monthly storage rate, applicable load-in and load-out charges
- load-in and load-out charges, when applicable, on peanuts forfeited to CCC.

2 Warehouse Charges

A Monthly Warehouse Charges

The monthly storage rates, load-in and load-out charges, when applicable, are on a per ton basis. The rates are provided in the following table.

The load-in charges include \$30 plus the initial grading and inspection fee as determined by the physical location of the buying point where the official farmer’s stock inspection was conducted. Since the load-in charges rate in the table includes the cost for grading the peanuts, the cost of this service is the warehouse operator’s responsibility and must be paid to AMS, Federal-State Inspection Service from the applicable load-in charge fees.
