Releasing 2010 Insurable Price File

1 Overview

A Background

Notice NAP-134:

- notified State and County Offices that there would be a delay in releasing the 2010 Insurable Price file to the 2010 national crop table (NCT)

Note: State Offices were instructed to manually override the prices in the 2010 NCT to ensure that a proper NAP payment was calculated.

- stated that once insurable prices have been updated, the manual price overrides would **not** be needed.

B Purpose

This notice informs State and County Offices that:

- the 2010 Insurable Price file has been completed and will be incorporated into the 2010 NCT Web Application on or about 6 p.m. c.t. June 21, 2010
- updated prices from the 2010 NCT Web Application will be transmitted to the County Office Crop Table
- any manually overridden prices, which were entered by the State Office according to Notice NAP-134, will be automatically modified to reflect the price in the 2010 Insurable Price file
- manual overrides are no longer required, as previously instructed in Notice NAP-134
- after receiving the new software, County Offices shall process an "All" batch for 2010 NAP payments and overpayments.

2 County Office Action

A Incorporating the 2010 Insurable Price File

The 2010 Insurable Price file has been completed and will be incorporated into the 2010 NCT Web Application on or about 6 p.m. c.t. June 21, 2010.

Any manually overridden prices that may have been entered into NCT as a result of Notice NAP-134 will be updated to reflect the price in the 2010 Insurable Price file. The 2010 NCT screens will contain different information, before and after the automatic price update.

Once prices are updated in the 2010 NCT Web Application, modified records will be transmitted within 48 hours to County Offices. If the County Office has any 2010 Applications for Payment, they should print the Crop Table Report as instructed in 1-NAP, paragraph 759 to:

- verify that prices are correct
- reprocess payments and overpayments according to subparagraph B.

B Re-Processing NAP Payments and Overpayments

The price difference may result in an underpayment or overpayment to the producer. After notification that the 2010 NCT Web Application has been transmitted to the System 36, County Offices shall take the following action.

Step	Action
1	Process 2010 NAP payments for “All” producers according to 1-NAP, paragraph 1321. During the integrated payment processing, the system will reread NCT and the application will be recalculated. If the recalculated payment results in additional funds due the producer, the additional payment will be issued.
2	Process 2010 NAP overpayments for “All” producers according to 1-NAP, paragraph 1365. During the overpayment processing, the application will be recalculated and if the producer is determined to be overpaid, an overpayment record will be created. County Offices should follow instructions in 1-NAP, paragraph 1365 to process the overpayment.
