

**Revised Policy for Issuing NAP Payments to Producers With 2008, 2009, and 2010  
Rainfall Index Pasture, Rangeland, and Forage (RI-PRF) Pilot Policies**

**1 Overview**

**A Background**

Notice NAP-138 notified State and County Offices:

- of the revised 2011 policy that producers can earn a PRF indemnity and NAP payment on the same acres for the same intended use
- of the procedures State and County Offices shall follow for issuing NAP payments to those producers that timely filed a 2008, 2009, or 2010 notice of loss and application for payment for the same crop and intended use covered by their RI-PRF policy
- that County Offices are authorized to issue NAP payments to producers who for 2008, 2009, and/or 2010 all of the following apply:
  - obtained an RI-PRF policy and NAP coverage on the same acreage for the same intended use
  - timely filed a notice of loss and application for payment according to 1-NAP for the applicable year of loss
  - met all other eligibility requirements of 1-NAP.

## Notice NAP-139

### 1 Overview (Continued)

#### B Purpose

This notice:

- revises the procedures that State and County Offices shall follow for issuing NAP payments to producers that timely filed a 2008, 2009, or 2010 notice of loss and application for payment for the same crop and intended use covered by their RI-PRF policy
- authorizes County Offices to issue NAP payments to producers that timely filed a 2008, 2009, or 2010 notice of loss and does either of the following:
  - timely filed a 2008, 2009, or 2010 application for payment for the same crop and intended use covered by their RI-PRF policy
  - files or has filed a late-filed application for payment for the same crop and intended use covered by their RI-PRF policy.

### 2 Issuing NAP Payments to Producers

#### A Issuing NAP Payments to Producers With RI-PRF Coverage for 2008, 2009, and 2010

County Offices are authorized to issue NAP payments to producers who for 2008, 2009, and/or 2010 timely:

- obtained an RI-PRF policy and NAP coverage on the same acreage for the same intended use
- filed a 2008, 2009, or 2010 notice of loss and does either of the following:
  - timely filed a 2008, 2009, or 2010 application for payment for the same crop and intended use covered by their RI-PRF policy
  - files or has filed a late-filed application for payment for the same crop and intended use covered by their RI-PRF policy

**Note: Applications for coverage and late-filed notices of loss will not be accepted for 2008, 2009, or 2010.**

- met all other eligibility requirements of 1-NAP.

## Notice NAP-139

### 3 Action

#### A State Office Action

SED's shall ensure that:

- all applicable County Offices are aware of the contents of this notice
- applicable County Offices complete the actions in subparagraph 2 A immediately upon receipt of this notice
- County Offices immediately notify producers with an RI-PRF policy who received an RI-PRF indemnity and timely filed a notice of loss but did not file an application for payment of the provisions for accepting a late-filed application for payment in subparagraph 2 A.

#### B County Office Action

CED's shall ensure that:

- the actions in subparagraph 2 A are completed immediately upon receipt of this notice
- producers with an RI-PRF policy who received an RI-PRF indemnity and timely filed a notice of loss but did not file an application for payment are immediately notified by all available means of the provisions for accepting a late-filed application for payment in subparagraph 2 A.
