1 Overview

A Background

To enable County Offices to timely process 2012 applications for coverage and collect service fees, rollover of the 2011 NCT records will take place on Friday, December 17, 2010, at 6 p.m. c.t. The 2012 NCT web application software will be available to State and County Offices on Monday, December 20, 2010.

B Purpose

This notice:

- provides the date that the 2011 NCT data will be captured to establish the initial records for the 2012 NCT
- alerts State and County Office employees that:
 - crop records loaded in the 2011 NCT will rollover to the 2012 NCT on December 17, 2010, at 6 p.m. c.t.
 - the 2012 NCT web application will be available December 20, 2010
 - the 2012 NAP Continuous Coverage and Application for Coverage software will be available December 20, 2010.

2 Establishing 2012 NCT Records

A Migrating 2011 NCT Data to 2012 NCT

All 2011 NCT records, including historical data, will rollover to the 2012 NCT **unless** the record has been inactive for 3 or more years (2008, 2009, and 2010). Records inactive for 3 or more years will **not** rollover.

Any updates to records, or new records added in the 2011 NCT **after** December 17, 2010, 6 p.m. c.t. will **not** be reflected in the 2012 NCT record. The user must access the record in the 2012 NCT to make the same updates or add the same new records.

B 2012 NCT Web Application

The 2012 NCT will be available to State and County Offices on or about December 20, 2010. Authorized NCT users may access NCT from the FSA Intranet at **http://fsaintranet.sc.egov.usda.gov/fsa/FSAIntranet_applications.html**.
