Section 32 Disaster Payments for Producers Not Associated to a Farm

1 Overview

A Background

Producers applying for Section 32 disaster payments are required to meet Conservation Compliance provisions, including filing AD-1026. A producer not associated with a farm will have a “No Association” Conservation Compliance determination, which is a good value for payment processing.

Example: The producer raises chickens under contract and is not associated to a farm. The producer suffered a loss of chickens because of Hurricane Katrina. Since the producer is not associated to a farm, AD-1026 has not been previously filed and, as such, a determination has not been updated to the web-based eligibility files.

AD-1026 was revised April 20, 2006, and provides for indicating that the producer does not have an interest in land that could produce an agricultural commodity.

Note: Producers who should be associated with a farm shall be loaded according to 3-CM.

B Purpose

This notice provides procedure for updating the AD-1026 determination for 2005 in the web-based eligibility file so producers not associated with a specific farm can receive a Section 32 disaster payment.

2 Action

A County Office Action

Producers who should be associated with a farm shall be loaded according to 3-CM.

If the producer was not associated to a farm in 2005, complete the following to ensure that AD-1026 flag for 2005 is updated to a good value.

- After printing AD-1026 for the producer without a specific farm, the producer shall:
 - complete AD-1026, items 1 through 4, indicating in item 4 that the producer did **not** have any interest in land that produced or could have produced an agricultural commodity in 2005
 - sign and date AD-1026, item 12.
- County Offices shall update the web-based subsidiary application according to this table.
