

1 Overview

A Background

Individuals and/or entities combined as 1 “person” for payment limitation purposes are entered in the System 36. Software to establish the combined files in a web-based environment is currently being tested. Once implemented, the combined files will:

- be updated on the web, such as subsidiary, SCIMS, and farm records
- only be entered/updated by the recording County Office
- be replicated to the System 36 until a time when the System 36 is not needed.

B Purpose

This notice:

- provides information about implementing the web-based combination software
- informs the County Office of the dataload of combined files to allow for planning of work.

2 Web-Based Combination Software

A Dataloading the Web-Based Combination Software

It has been determined that the web-based combination data will be data-loaded rather than migrated. Dataloading will allow for a review of combined files and help ensure that the loaded information is accurate. Only a combined recording county will dataload multi-county combinations. The combined recording county is normally the county whose COC approved CCC-503A determining the combined producer.

During the dataload period, the combined recording county will be required to load **new** combinations in the web-based system and the System 36. Other counties where the **new** combination exists will be required to load the combination in the System 36 during the dataload period.

B Report Available Before Dataload

A new report will be available for County Offices to use called the Combined Producer Dataload Report. This report will identify every producer in that county who is shown as being in a combination. County Offices will be allowed a 60-calendar-day window to load all combined producers into the new web-based software. Web-based combination software is scheduled to open on March 19, 2007. Instructions for using the web-based combination software will be in a forthcoming 3-PL amendment.

C Accessing the Combined Producer Dataload Report

Access the Combined Producer Dataload Report according to the following table.

Step	Menu	Action
1	FAX250	ENTER "3" or "4", "Application Processing", and PRESS "Enter".
2	FAX09002	If "4" was selected in step 1, then enter the appropriate county and PRESS "Enter".
3	FAX07001	ENTER "9", "Common Provisions", and PRESS "Enter".
4	MA0000	ENTER "4", "Subsidiary Files Maintenance", and PRESS "Enter".
5	MAD000	ENTER "4", "Combined Producers", and PRESS "Enter".
6	MAD300	ENTER "4", "Combined Producer Dataload Report", and PRESS "Enter".
7	MBAPRT01	Enter a valid printer ID and PRESS "Enter".
