**1 Overview**

**A Background**

Recently, the President signed legislation that provides for funding through the end of FY 2011. As a result, the hiring freeze is lifted and hiring officials within each Deputy Administrative area for the National Office and within each State for Field Offices are authorized to hire within their budget parameters.

**B Purpose**

This notice:

- rescinds the temporary hiring freeze for all GS and CO positions
- requires managers and hiring officials to use prudence in making recruitment decisions within current budgetary constraints for FY 2011
- obsoletes Notice PM-2800.

### 2 Personnel Decisions

#### A Personnel Actions

No other personnel actions, such as career promotions, temporary promotions, or reassignments internal to FSA, are impacted by this notice.

Hiring officials should ensure that adequate funding exists **before** sending a request for recruitment to their servicing human resources office.

The waiver process to fill supervisory grade GS-13 positions and above remains in effect and requires prior approval by the FSA Administrator for all offices **except** State and County Offices. See Notice PM-2785 for information about waivers.

#### B Student Intern Employment

No additional student interns will be hired in FY 2011.
