1 Overview

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Background

County Release No. 439 includes updated 2000 crop year eligibility queries for the following:

- contract commodities:
 - barley
 - oats
 - grain sorghum
 - wheat
 - corn
 - rice
 - upland cotton
- noncontract commodities
 - canola
 - flaxseed
 - rapeseed
 - soybeans
 - sunflower seed, other type.
 - ELS cotton
 - mustard seed
 - safflower
 - sunflower seed, oil type

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2 Software Modifications

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2000 Crop Year Eligibility Queries

Price support eligibility queries:

- are accessed through Screen PQA01100
- require County Offices to enter the COC-established yield for the applicable commodity set according to 8-LP, paragraph 132.

Follow procedures in this table to replace the default COC-established yield in each query. Use Exhibit 1 to determine the applicable 3-letter commodity abbreviation.

Step	Action
1	On a command line, Enter "QRY" and PRESS "Enter" to access the Work With Queries Screen on Price Support Main Menu PCA005.
2	On the Work With Queries Screen, ENTER "2" to modify the applicable query. Example: ELGXXX00 where "XXX" is the 3-letter commodity abbreviation.
3	On the Define the Query Screen, ENTER "1", "Define result fields", and PRESS "Enter".
4	On the Define Result Fields Screen, replace the default "100" of COCYLD with the COC-authorized program payment yield, and PRESS "Enter".
5	On the Define the Query Screen, PRESS "Cmd7" to run and save the query.
6	On the End This Query Screen, PRESS "Enter".
7	On the Work With Query Screen, PRESS "Cmd7".

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3 Additional Information About Eligibility Queries

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Linking Files

Eligibility queries will run only when the applicable files are linked to the correct file definitions in the correct data dictionary. Normally, this linking process runs automatically and is not apparent to the user.

Occasionally, the user may receive a query screen message that a particular file is not linked to a file definition. The user can link any unlinked query file with the correct file definition in the correct data dictionary by following steps similar to those provided in the examples in this table.

IF this message displays...	THEN, to link files, on a command line ENTER...
“File A.ME.SOM not linked to a file definition...”	“IDDULINK_LINK,A.ME.SOM,IDDEF01,AMESOM”, and PRESS “Enter”. In this example: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A.ME.SOM represents the file name• IDDEF01 represents the data dictionary• AMESOM represents the file definition.
“File A.ME.P0M not linked to a file definition...”	IDDULINK_LINK,A.ME.P0M,IDDEF01,AMEP0M”, and PRESS “Enter”. In this example: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A.ME.P0M represents the file name• IDDEF01 represents the data dictionary• AMEP0M represents the file definition.
“File A.MG.PFM not linked to a file definition...”	“IDDULINK_LINK,A.MG.PFM,IDDEF03,AMGPFM”, and PRESS “Enter”. In this example: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A.MG.PFM represents the file name• IDDEF03 represents the data dictionary• AMGPFM represents the file definition.

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3 Additional Information About Eligibility Queries (Continued)

A Linking Files (Continued)

IF this message displays...	THEN, to link files, on a command line ENTER...
“File A.MA.NAM not linked to a file definition...”	“IDDULINK_LINK,A.MA.NAM,IDDEF01,AMANAM”, and PRESS “Enter”. In this example: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A.MA.NAM represents the file name• IDDEF01 represents the data dictionary• AMANAM represents the file definition.

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C Printing Queries

When printing queries, select the landscape print format to ensure that all columns of information provided by query are visible when printed on letter-size paper.

To change the printer format to print:

- **landscape**, type “PRINT_P2,,,,,COR”, where P2 is the printer ID of the printer that the user wants to use
 - **portrait**, type PRINT_P2,,,,,0”, where P2 is the printer ID of the printer that the user wants to use.
