**Revising and Building Price Support Eligibility Queries for Current Year
PFC Data and Contract Commodities Produced on Non-Contract Farms**

1 Overview

A

Background

County Release No. 439 provided software for running 2000 crop year (CY) price support eligibility queries.

Notice PS-362 provided instructions for:

- accessing 2000 CY price support eligibility queries
- revising price support eligibility queries for COC-established yields
- linking files when necessary.

Farms with new FSN's and PFC contract modifications resulting from reconstitutions processed during the past crop year will not be picked up by 2000 CY price support eligibility queries, unless the applicable **contract** commodity query is revised for that purpose.

Notice PS-366 provided instructions for revising price support eligibility queries.

Purpose

This notice:

- provides **revised** instructions for:
 - revising eligibility queries for **contract** commodities:
 - for current year PFC data resulting from PFC changes and reconstitutions
 - that list production from farms **covered** by PFC
 - enhancing eligibility queries to list FSN's in ascending order
 - building new eligibility queries for a **contract** commodity that lists production from **all** farms together, from both those:
 - covered by PFC
 - **not covered** by PFC
 - obsoletes Notice PS-366.

2 Revising and Building Price Support Eligibility Queries

A

Sources of Data 2000 CY price support eligibility queries call information from these files:

- “A.ME.SOM”, compliance farm summary
- “A.ME.POM”, producer share
- “A.MG.PFM”, AMTA contract
- “A.MA.NAM”, name and address.

To provide the most **recent** PFC information, each **contract** commodity query must be revised each year to select data from “signature” field in “A.MG.PFM”.

Current Year PFC Data Follow this table to **revise** 2000 CY price support eligibility queries for each **contract** commodity that will list production from all farms **covered** by PFC. See Exhibit 1 for applicable query name.

Step	Action	Result
1	On Price Support Main Menu PCA005, ENTER “QRY” on command line. PRESS “Enter”.	Work With Queries Screen will be displayed.
2	On Work With Queries Screen, ENTER “2”, to revise applicable query. Enter applicable query name in “Query name” field. Note: Ensure that “QRPRICE1” is displayed in the “Library name” field. PRESS “Enter”.	Define the Query Screen will be displayed.
3	On Define the Query Screen, ENTER “1” in “Select a file” field. PRESS “Enter”.	Select a File Screen will be displayed.

5	On Define the Query Screen, ENTER “1” in “Define Results Fields”. PRESS “Enter”.	Define Results Fields will be displayed.
6	<p>On Define Results Fields Screen:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • move cursor to COCYLD field • DELETE the yield that appears under the “Arithmetic Expression” column • enter the assigned COC yield for that crop • PRESS “Enter”. 	Define the Query Screen will be displayed.
7	On Define the Query Screen, ENTER “1” in “Select and Sequence Fields”. PRESS “Enter”.	Select and Sequence Fields Screen will be displayed.

Define the Query Screen will be displayed.
9	On Define the Query Screen, ENTER “1” in “Select Records” field. PRESS “Enter”.	Select Records Screen will be displayed.
10	<p>On Select Records Screen:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • move cursor to first “D.SIGND3”, the “1999 signature” field • enter “D.SIGND4” in place of “D.SIGND3”, for 2000 signature information • roll-up and move cursor to second “D.SIGND3”, the “1999 signature” field • ENTER “D.SIGND4” in place of “D.SIGND3” for 2000 signature information • PRESS “Enter”. 	Define the Query Screen will be displayed.
11	On Define the Query Screen, ENTER “1” in “Select Sort Fields” field. PRESS “Enter”.	Select Sort Fields Screen will be displayed.

Production From ALL Farms For 2000 CY production **only**, LDP’s are authorized for **contract** commodities from farms **not** covered by PFC. Follow this table to build a query for a **contract** commodity that will list production from **all** farms together, from both those:

- covered by a PFC
- **not** covered by PFC.

Step	Action	Result
1	On Price Support Main Menu PCA005, ENTER “QRY” on a command line. PRESS “Enter”.	Work With Queries Screen will be displayed.
2	On Work With Queries Screen: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ENTER “3” to copy desired query • enter query name “ELGSOY00” to copy • ensure that “QRPRICE1” is displayed in “Library name” field • PRESS “Enter”. 	Copy Queries Screen will be displayed.
3	On Copy Queries Screen: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • move cursor down to “To Name” column • rename the query that you just copied, for example, if the new query is for cotton, you might name it “UCT00” • PRESS “Enter”. 	Work With Query Screen will be displayed.
4	<p>Note: Before executing this step, be sure the file prefix has been revised according to subparagraph 2 B, Step 4.</p> On Work With Query Screen: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ENTER “2” in the “Option” field • enter new query name from Step 3 in “Query name” field • PRESS “Enter”. 	Define the Query Screen will be displayed.
5	On Define the Query Screen, ENTER “1” in “Define Results Fields”. PRESS “Enter”.	Define Results Fields will be displayed.

7	On Define the Query Screen, ENTER “1” in “Select Records” field. PRESS “Enter”.	Select Records Screen will be displayed.
8	On Select Records Screen: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the cursor will be on the first “A.CROPCD” in the Field column • tab right to the Value column and revise field to reflect commodity crop code for applicable contract commodity, for example, “0021” for upland cotton (See Exhibit 1) • move cursor to second “A.CROPCD” in the Field column on that screen • tab right to the Value column and revise field to reflect commodity crop code for applicable contract commodity • PRESS “Enter”. 	Define the Query Screen will be displayed.
9	On Define the Query Screen, ENTER “1” in “Select Sort Fields” field. PRESS “Enter”.	Select Sort Fields Screen will be displayed.

11	On Define the Query Screen: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ENTER “1” in Select Output Device and Output Type Screen • PRESS “Enter” several times. 	Specify Cover Page and Headings Screen will be displayed.
12	On Specify Cover Page and Headings Screen, the cover page title, heading, and footing should be revised to insert the commodity this revised query reflects and to omit reference to loans since contract commodities on nonparticipating farms are not eligible for loans. Revise as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cover page title: “Estimated (insert commodity) production based on reported and determined crop acres for 2000 (omit “Loan and”) LDP eligibility” • Page heading: “2000 (insert commodity) ELIGIBILITY” • Page footing: “NOTE: Use for ESTIMATING eligible production for (omit “Loan and”) LDP only. Press “Enter”.	Define the Query Screen will be displayed.

13	On Define the Query Screen: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PRESS “Cmd7” • On End This Query Screen revise the “Comment about the query” field as follows: “2000 (insert commodity) ELIGIBILITY REPORT” • PRESS “Enter” to save and run the newly built query.

D

Printing Queries

When printing queries, select landscape print format to ensure that all columns of information provided are visible when printed on letter-size paper.

To change printer format to print:

- **landscape**, enter “PRINT P2,,,,,COR”, where “P2” is the desired printer ID
 - **portrait**, enter “PRINT P2,,,,,0”, where “P2” is the desired printer ID.

Linking Files

Eligibility queries will run only when applicable files are linked to the correct file definitions in the correct data dictionary. If it becomes necessary to link files after making revisions according to this notice, see Notice PS-362, subparagraph 3 B.
