**Instructions for Processing In-Process Sugar Loan Settlements in APSS**

**1 Overview**

**A Background**

The Farm Security and Rural Investment Act of 2002 now provides for a new type of marketing assistance loan for sugar called “In-Process” loans. These loans are available to processors of domestically grown sugarcane and sugar beets for In-Process sugars and syrups.

In-Process sugar loans are not available for any of the following:

- raw sugar
- liquid sugar
- invert syrup
- other finished products.

All In-Process cane or beet sugar loans are processed as **farm-stored** certified loans according to 10-SU, paragraph 128. Premiums and discounts apply to **In-Process cane** sugar loans, after a **processed quantity** has been determined, at **settlement** and **not** at loanmaking.

Software for processed sugar loan **forfeitures** is now being developed and will be released in the near future.

**B Purpose**

This notice provides County Offices with instructions for processing In-Process sugar loan **settlements** in APSS.

**Note:** 10-SU will be amended to contain the APSS instructions provided in this notice and for sugar forfeitures.

### 2 Settlement Information

#### A Computing the In-Process Settlement Value

The In-Process loan settlement value is calculated according to the following steps.

- The loan value for the “entered” **processed sugar quantity** (see subparagraph 3 A, step 6,) is recalculated using 100 percent of the applicable loan rate.
- If the settlement is for:
  - cane sugar, premiums and discounts are applied to the loan value
  - if the settlement is for beet sugar, premiums and discounts do **not** apply.
- The settlement value is the difference between the initial in-process loan value and the above computation. If an amount is due to:
  - the producer, the amount is issued to the producer
  - CCC, a receivable is established for that amount.

#### B Processing Settlements in APSS

The settlement process in APSS shall be used for In-Process sugar loans that are delivered because those loans were originally issued as farm-stored loans. However, because In Process sugar loan quantities must be converted to a processed or refined quantity to facilitate a delivery, the APSS settlement process in paragraph 3 uses “warehouse” screens. Beginning with paragraph 3, step 7, the user entries according to steps 7 through 12 shall be made according to the warehouse receipt or KC-227, as applicable.

**A In-Process Sugar Loan Settlements**

County Offices shall complete In-Process sugar loan settlements according to the following.

5	On Screen PSA05000: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ENTER “Y” or “N”, as applicable to the question, “Has this in-process sugar loan quantity been converted to processed sugar?”</li> </ul> <p><b>Note:</b> Loan quantity has to be converted before settlement process will continue.</p> PRESS “ENTER”.	<b>If:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Yes,</b> Screen PSA10000 will be displayed.</li> <li>• <b>No,</b> Main Menu PCA005 will be displayed.</li> </ul>

7	On Screen PSA10005: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ENTER “1”, “Warehouse Storage”</li> <li>• PRESS “Enter”.</li> </ul>	Screen PSA11000 will be displayed.
8	On Screen PSA11000, enter the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• warehouse receipt/lot number</li> <li>• moisture when received (if excessive )</li> <li>• date commodity deposited (mmddy)</li> <li>• date receipt issued (mmddy)</li> <li>• gross pounds</li> <li>• net weight (bu., cwt., lb.)</li> <li>• warehouse code where delivered</li> <li>• polarity degree.</li> </ul> <p><b>Note:</b> When entering an In-Process <b>beet</b> sugar settlement you <b>will not</b> be prompted to enter the polarity degree. Polarity degree only applies to In-Process cane sugar settlements.</p> PRESS “Enter”.	Screen PSA02501 will be displayed.
