1 Overview

A Background

To protect the privacy of FSA customers, only the last 4 digits of a producer’s identification number will be printed on certain computer-generated forms.

B Purpose

This notice informs State and County Offices that APSS has been modified to print the last 4 digits of a Social Security number (SSN), employee identification number (EIN), or taxpayer identification number (TIN) on computer-generated Price Support documents.
