**Automated Price Support System (APSS) Enhancements to
County Committee (COC) Yield Table**

1 Overview

A Background

County Offices record for most commodity crops on a crop year basis COC-establish yields for irrigated and non-irrigated yields in APSS. County Offices do **not** record COC-established yields for honey.

COC Yield Table files are used in the Price Support Basic Eligibility and Running Account Queries. COC Yield Table file is used in the loan maturity queries. Since honey is **not** recorded in COC Yield Table file, honey has not been supported by the automated loan maturity letters.

Enhancements have been made to COC Yield Table file to include honey so that automated loan maturity letters may be processed.

When COC Yield Table is selected for printing, Virginia (VIR) peanuts have not been printing. Modifications to the software have been made to include VIR peanuts in the printout.

B Purpose

This notice informs State and County Offices of APSS enhancements to COC Yield Table.

2 Software Enhancements

A Updating COC Yield Table

Enhancements have been made to COC Yield Table to:

- include commodity honey
- hard code, both irrigated and non irrigated yield fields to “1”
- field protect honey yield
- display message “Honey will be included here with a fixed yield factor of “1” for purposes of printing maturity letters.”

B Printing COC Yield Table

Changes have been made to include printing VIR Peanuts when option 12 from Menu PAA0020 is entered.

3 Action

A County Office Action

County Offices shall access COC Yield Update Table to trigger APSS enhancements.

To access COC Yield Table, County Offices shall select:

- Option 9 from Main Price Support Menu
- Option 3 from Administrative Main Menu
- Option 2 from County Table Functions Menu
- Option 6 from Update/Print County Tables Menu
- Crop year “04”
- “Enter” through the menus until the crop year menu reappears.

Note: County Offices will **not** see hard code “1” for honey when accessing COC Yield Table for the first time. When COC Yield Table is re-accessed, hard code “1” will then appear for honey.
