**Electronic Loan Deficiency Payment (eLDP) Software Enhancements to Include
All Service Center Information Management System (SCIMS) Business Types
and Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) Override Provisions**

1 Overview

A Background

eLDP customer profiles can be established for individuals, joint operations, and some entities. eLDP software has been enhanced to now support customer profiles for **all** SCIMS business types.

When eLDP customer profiles are established, the eLDP web software uses the web AGI subsidiary service and returns the combined permitted entity share/AGI determination. When the determination is zero, a customer profile cannot be established. eLDP software enhancements have been made to allow County Offices to override the combined permitted entity/AGI determination to establish a customer profile.

B Purpose

This notice informs State and County Offices of the recent eLDP software enhancements that include the following:

- additional SCIMS business types
- combined permitted entity/AGI override provisions.

2 eLDP Software Enhancements

A Additional SCIMS Business Types

eLDP customer profiles can now be established for **all** SCIMS business types. See 1-CM, Exhibit 11 for a list of SCIMS business types. Customer profiles must be established before an eLDP request can be processed.

B Combined Permitted Entity/AGI Override Provisions for eLDP

When customer profiles are established, the eLDP software will use the subsidiary web service to determine eligibility. When the combined permitted share/AGI returns a zero determination, County Offices will have the capability to override the determination.

Note: County Offices shall **only** override the zero combined permitted share/AGI when it has been determined that the calculated combined permitted share is incorrect.
