**Using a Batch Process to Automatically Update Customer Profiles  
When COC Yield Has Been Revised**

**1 Overview**

**A Background**

eLDP software uses the COC yield table to determine reasonable and allocated quantities for customer profiles.

When the COC yield has been revised, changes made to the table **after** a customer profile has been established:

- do **not** automatically update the following:
  - reasonable quantities
  - allocated quantities
  - revised COC yields
- required County Offices to access “Change Producer” to trigger changes.

Software has been enhanced to provide a “behind the scene” batch process that will automatically update customer profiles without intervention from County Offices.

**B Purpose**

This notice informs State and County Offices of eLDP enhancements for a batch process to automatically update a producer’s customer profile.

### 2 Software Enhancements

#### A Updating Customer Profiles

Customer profiles will be automatically updated according to the following table.

<b>IF...</b>	<b>THEN the software will...</b>
new calculated reasonable quantity is <b>equal to or greater than</b> total quantity disbursed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• update reasonable quantity</li><li>• update allocated quantity when the original allocated quantity equals the original reasonable quantity.</li></ul>
new calculated reasonable quantity is <b>less than</b> total quantity disbursed	not update. A potential overpayment exists.  An e-mail to the County Office is generated advising them to review the profile and manually make any necessary adjustments.
new calculated reasonable quantity is <b>less than</b> allocated quantity	update reasonable quantity.  The allocated quantity will be revised to equal the amount of the new calculated reasonable quantity.  An e-mail to the County Office is generated to review the profile and manually make any necessary adjustments if original allocated quantity was manually modified from the "default" allocated quantity.
COC yield was revised in the producer's customer profile	not make any adjustments.
COC yield equals "default" yield	update yield in the customer profile.

#### B Running the Batch Process

The batch process will run nightly during nonpeak hours.
