**Tobacco Transition Payment Program (TTPP) Successor-In-Interest (SII)**

**1 Overview**

**A Background**

TTPP allows contract holders to transfer their rights to third parties in exchange for a lump-sum payment equal to or greater than the discount value rate established by CCC. SII contracts will be allowed beginning with the FY 2006 payment.

In order to facilitate this process, CCC is developing an on-line processing system to allow the third party successors to submit on-line requests to be successors to contracts.

**B Purpose**

This notice provides information related to SII contracts.

### 2 Action

#### A County Office Action

County Offices shall:

- continue to process CCC-955's and CCC-956's from quota holders and producers
- make contract corrections (incorrect TIN, incorrect BQL, voluntary termination, involuntary termination, and divisions of an existing contract due to death) when software is available

**Note:** A forthcoming TB notice will address these corrections.

- provide information regarding registration for a TTPP account according to subparagraph C.
- inform quota holders or producers when they request information regarding SII that the parties registered with CCC to provide lump-sum payments can be found at [www.fsa.usda.gov/tobacco](http://www.fsa.usda.gov/tobacco)
- not accept CCC-962's, CCC-963's, CCC-968's, CCC-969's, or CCC-970's when they become available to the public.

#### C SII Forms and List of Registered Lump-Sum Providers

CCC-963, Tobacco Transition Payment Program Account Registration, is currently available at [www.fsa.usda.gov/tobacco](http://www.fsa.usda.gov/tobacco). CCC-963 establishes an account that would allow the applicant to become a successor to a CCC-955 or CCC-956.
