



## **USDA Announces Availability of Low-Interest Physical Loss Loans for Producers Affected by Excessive Rain, Flash Flood, Flooding, Tornado, Hail, and High Winds**

**News Release | Texas | May 30, 2024**

Physical loss loans through the United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) can help producers repair or replace damaged or destroyed physical property essential to the success of the agricultural operation, including livestock losses. Examples of property commonly affected include essential farm buildings, fixtures to real estate, equipment, livestock, perennial crops, fruit and nut bearing trees, and harvested or stored crops and hay.

**Impacted Area:** Texas

**Triggering Disaster:** Flash Flood, Excessive Rain, and Flooding occurring on April 7, 2024, through May 6, 2024

**Application Deadline:** January 13, 2025

**Primary County Eligible:** Panola

**Contiguous Counties Also Eligible:** Harrison, Rusk, and Shelby

**Louisiana:** Caddo and DeSoto

**Triggering Disaster 2:** Flash Flood and Excessive Rain occurring on April 22, 2024, through May 7, 2024

**Application Deadline:** January 13, 2025

**Primary Counties Eligible:** Brazos, Grimes, and Walker

**Contiguous Counties Also Eligible:** Burleson, Houston, Leon, Madison, Montgomery, Robertson, San Jacinto, Trinity, Waller, and Washington

**Triggering Disaster 3:** Tornado, Excessive Rain, Hail, and High Winds occurring on April 27, 2024

**Application Deadline:** January 13, 2025

**Primary Counties Eligible:** Baylor

**Contiguous Counties Also Eligible:** Archer, Foard, Haskell, Knox, Throckmorton, Wichita, Wilbarger, and Young

**Triggering Disaster 4:** Flooding and Excessive Rain occurring on May 1, 2024, through May 2, 2024

**Application Deadline:** January 13, 2025

**Primary Counties Eligible:** Anderson, Houston, Leon, and Madison

**Contiguous Counties Also Eligible:** Angelina, Brazos, Cherokee, Freestone, Grimes, Henderson, Limestone, Robertson, Trinity, and Walker
