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## **USDA Announces Availability of Low-Interest Physical Loss Loans for Producers Affected by Flash Flood, Hail, and High Winds**

**News Release | Texas | May 30, 2024**

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Physical loss loans through the United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) can help producers repair or replace damaged or destroyed physical property essential to the success of the agricultural operation, including livestock losses. Examples of property commonly affected include essential farm buildings, fixtures to real estate, equipment, livestock, perennial crops, fruit and nut bearing trees, and harvested or stored crops and hay.

**Triggering Disaster:** Flash Flood, Hail, and High Winds occurring on May 9, 2024

**Application Deadline:** January 21, 2025

**Primary County Eligible:** Grayson

**Contiguous Counties Also Eligible:** Collin, Cooke, Denton, and Fannin

**Oklahoma:** Bryan, Love, and Marshall

**Triggering Disaster 2:** Hail and High Winds occurring on May 9, 2024

**Application Deadline:** January 21, 2025

**Primary Counties Eligible:** Williamson

**Contiguous Counties Also Eligible:** Bastrop, Bell, Burnet, Lee, Milam, and Travis
