



USDA Announces Availability of Low-Interest Physical Loss Loans for Producers in Seven Iowa Counties Impacted by Excessive Rain and Flooding

Physical loss loans through the United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) can help producers repair or replace damaged or destroyed physical property essential to the success of the agricultural operation, including livestock losses. Examples of property commonly affected include essential farm buildings, fixtures to real estate, equipment, livestock, perennial crops, fruit and nut bearing trees, and harvested or stored crops and hay.

Triggering Disaster

Impacted Area: Iowa

Administrator Notification Code: N1754

Application Deadline: March 13, 2025

Triggering Disaster: Flooding, excessive rain, and flash floods. Incidence period began June 1, 2024, and is ongoing.

Primary Counties Eligible: Fourteen Counties in Minnesota

Contiguous Counties Also Eligible: Dickinson, Emmet, Howard, Kossuth, Lyon, Osceola, and Winneshiek (Iowa)
